

Minutes of the Meeting of the Monett City Council
June 7th, 2023

The Monett City Council for a work session, Wednesday, June 7th, 2023 at 9:00 a.m. at Monett City Hall in Monett, Missouri. In attendance was as follows: Mike Brownsberger, Mayor; Al Dohmen, Commission; Ken Gaspar, Commissioner; Chris Weiner, City Administrator, and Mike Gervais, Monett Times.

Mayor Brownsberger called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m.

Discussion Regarding Street Widening Ordinance

City Administrator Weiner presented the draft ordinance requiring wider streets in newly constructed subdivisions of the community zoned in categories A, MH, and Mobile Home Parks. Council reviewed the document and instructed Administrator Weiner to place the ordinance on the June agenda.

Discussion Regarding Airport Hangar and Permitting Ordinance

City Administrator Weiner presented the draft ordinance establishing new hangar construction standards and permitting requirements at the Monett Regional Airport. Council discussed the regulations and instructed Administrator Weiner to place the ordinance on the June agenda.

Discussion Regarding Water Main Extension Outside the City Limits

City Administrator Weiner presented information on a local developer's request to extend City water service outside the City limits to serve a housing development adjacent to the City. Council authorized City Administrator Weiner to proceed with the water main extension.

Discussion Regarding Dispatching Operations

City Administrator Weiner presented information on the final payment from the Lawrence County Emergency Services Board. Council discussed the situation and instructed Administrator Weiner to return the payment and seek full contractual payment.

Discussion Regarding Downtown Parking Lot Collapse


City Administrator Weiner provided information on the recent partial collapse of the City's downtown parking lot. The Council instructed Administrator Weiner to continue pursuing options for the parking lot.

Discussion Regarding the Creation of a TIME Zone Economic Development District

City Administrator Weiner presented information on the TIME Zone opportunity and his meeting with the Barry County Commission on the same topic. Council instructed Administrator Weiner to proceed.
