

Minutes of the Meeting of the Monett City Council
March 15th, 2023

The Monett City Council for a work session, Wednesday, March 15th, 2023 at 4:00 p.m. at Monett City Hall in Monett, Missouri. In attendance was as follows: Mike Brownsberger, Mayor; Al Dohmen, Commission; Ken Gaspar, Commissioner; and Chris Weiner, City Administrator.

Mayor Brownsberger called the meeting to order at 4:01 p.m.

First and Second Reading of Bill and Ordinance 8952: Maintaining a Five Percent License Tax on Natural Gas Providers

City Administrator Weiner presented ordinance 8952 for a first and second reading and explained that the ordinance will keep in place the current license tax on natural gas providers. Commissioner Dohmen motioned to pass ordinance 8952, while Mayor Brownsberger seconded the motion. The following vote was recorded: Brownsberger – yes, Dohmen – yes, Gaspar – yes.

Discussion Regarding Dispatching Transition



Discussion Regarding 2023-2024 Budget

City Administrator Weiner presented the revised draft of the 2023-2024 budget. Council directed Administrator Weiner to make a few changes to the proposed budget for final approval.
