Update on Central Avenue and Roundabout Project

City Administrator Weiner provided an update on the ongoing design work and progress of the Central Avenue and Roundabout project. There will be an updated cost-share modification proposal to send to the Missouri Department of Transportation on the November 19th agenda.

Update on Chapell Drive Overpass Project

City Administrator Weiner provided an update and the engineer's preliminary cost estimate for the Chapell Drive Overpass Project.

Update on Redwood Development Housing Project

City Administrator Weiner provided an update on the Redwood Development Housing Project. City Administrator Weiner recommended that the City Council reach out to the Missouri Housing Development Commission and express the need for this development in our community.

Any Other Items of Interest


City Administrator Weiner gave an update on discussions with the local YMCA and their proposal for renewal of the contract for management of the outdoor City-owned pool.
