Physical Requirements:

Required high levels of sitting, standing, walking, running, squatting, lifting, bending twisting, and kneeling: requires manual dexterity sufficient to operate essential job-related equipment, must be sighted, hearing and mobile to such a degree as not to compromise safety rules or the safety of self and others while working. Reaching to both ground level and overhead is required for tasks such as retrieving files; lifts and carries up to 60 pounds; pushes and pulls up to 60 pounds; holds and grips objects; Must possess manual dexterity necessary to operate a computer keyboard; Must possess strength and skill needed to control large animals; Must be able to maintain and demonstrate the ability to use animal control tools, tranquilizer gun and traps.

Working Environment:

Performs most work outside in all weather conditions. Perform heavy cleaning of the indoor and outdoor areas of the animal shelter. Performs prolonged walking or standing.

Education, Experience, Training

Completed High School Diploma or equivalent Must be 21 years of age, U.S. citizen. Non-Convicted felon. Completion of accredited animal control officer training within one year of employment.

Licensing/Certification:

Must possess a valid Missouri operator's license.
