MOVING MONETT FORWARD – PHASE 2 THE CITY OF MONETT’S TRANSPORTATION SALES TAX EXTENSION

On Tuesday, April 7th, voters in Monett will have the opportunity to vote on the City’s next phase of the Transportation Improvement Plan known as “Moving Monett Forward”. This new plan will extend the existing one-half cent sales tax for another ten years in order to continue to make street improvements specifically focusing on building an overpass of the BNSF railroad on Chapell Drive. This would eliminate the last at-grade railroad crossing in Monett.

The benefits of an overpass include improved safety for vehicular traffic, uninterrupted and faster response times for emergency responders, a new designated truck route with more direct access to our industrial park and the establishment of a railroad “quiet zone” through Monett.

If the sales tax is renewed, the City intends to make the following improvements in addition to the Chapell Drive overpass:

- Complete the Central Avenue project that includes sidewalk, drainage and street improvements from Broadway to Cleveland;
- Construct a roundabout at Broadway & Central;
- Improve Bridle Lane from Hwy 60 north to County Road;
- Continue to replace 1-2 miles of sidewalks each year;
- Overlay major streets including Cleveland, Eisenhower, Kyler/13th Street, and Broadway;
- Improve Kyler/13th Street from the Centennial Bridge to Cleveland Avenue (Business 60) by widening the roadway, installing curb and gutter, and sidewalks.

Voters had approved Phase 1 of the City’s Transportation Improvement Plan in August, 2015, and since 2016 the City has completed the following improvements:

- New sidewalks on Scott Street from Cox Hospital to the Monett Middle School;
- New sidewalks on Dunn and Lincoln to the Monett Elementary School;
- Turn lane and intersection improvements on Hwy 60 and Hwy 37 for southbound and west bound traffic in partnership with MoDOT;
- Construction of a new connector road (Enterprise Dr.) between Chapell Dr. and Bridle Lane that will connect the new overpass to the industrial park;
- Realigned Callan St. to Bridle Lane to allow for local business expansion;
- Overlay of Dairy St. from Hwy 37 to Kyler;
- Engineering studies for Central Avenue and the 9th & Cleveland intersection;
- Provided the local match requirement for on-going capital improvements to Monett Regional Airport.
