MOVING MONETT FORWARD – PHASE 2 THE CITY OF MONETT’S TRANSPORTATION SALES TAX RENEWAL

- Election has been re-scheduled for Tuesday, June 2nd.
- Polls open from 6:00 a.m. until 7:00 p.m. at the Monett Park Casino in South Park (Barry Co. voters) and the Presbyterian Church at 700 Sycamore (Lawrence Co. voters). There will be in-person voting at these poll locations on the day of the election.
- The City of Monett is asking voters to renew the half-cent sales tax for transportation.
- The tax will have a sunset of ten years, if approved.
- The existing sales tax expires in April, 2023, and the City is asking for a ten-year renewal to begin work on the Chapell Drive overpass and to continue existing programs that improve and enhance the City’s roadway and pedestrian networks.
- The sales tax extension will allow the City to continue the Sidewalk Improvement Program, Sidewalk Reimbursement to Homeowner Program, Smoother & Safer Asphalt Overlay Program and to complete roadway and pedestrian improvements on Central Avenue (Hwy 37) and Thirteenth Street (Business 60).
- A new overpass on Chapell Drive will (A) benefit local traffic and commercial traffic in and out of the City’s Industrial Park as this route will become the designated truck route; (B) allow for unrestricted access to and from the new Cox Monett Hospital for emergency vehicles; and (C) allow for better access for fire and police responses including rural fire response to areas north and east of Monett.

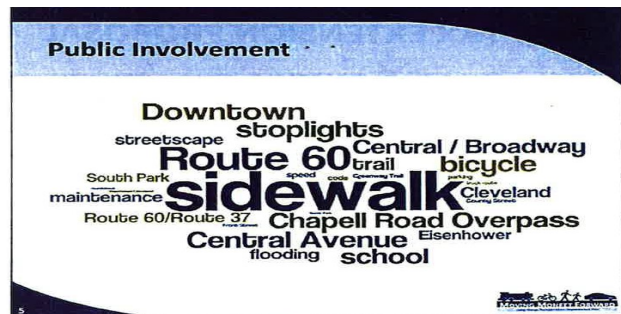
