ORGANIZATIONAL MEETING Wednesday, January 4, 2021 9:00 AM

The organizational meeting was called to order by County Clerk, Kristen Millard, at 9:00 a.m.

The meeting opened with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Members present: Commissioners Miller, Mahar, Beach, Johnston, Carr, Baker, Stowell and Petersen. Members absent: None. Members attending remotely, but not yet sworn in or able to vote, Commissioner Kohn.

Others present: Kristen Millard, Brenda Taeter, Eric Smith, Michelle Becker, Lori Wilson, Todd Sattler and Elisabeth Waldon.

The first order of business was the election of a Chairman for the next two years. Kristen Millard, County Clerk, stated she would now accept nominations for Chairman. Commissioner Baker placed Patrick Carr's name in nomination. Moved by Commissioner Baker, supported by Commissioner Beach that the nominations be closed and a unanimous ballot be cast for Patrick Carr as Chairman for the next two years. Motion carried.

Moved by Commissioner Beach, supported by Commissioner Baker to adopt the Board of Commissioners Meeting Schedule as proposed by the County Controller.

Under discussion Chairman Carr stated that he is not in favor of continuing the 6 p.m. meeting times. Attendance has not improved since changing to the 6 p.m. time. Commissioner Mahar stated that he feels that at least one meeting should still be held at 6 p.m. Commissioner Baker stated that he feels a 4 p.m. meeting time is more feasible for employees and department heads to attend.

However, the Board does that the authority to take official action in an emergency situation. He cautioned the board that it would not be a good practice to get into to vote on issues during the Committee of the Whole.

Brenda Taeter, County Controller, presented the board with the proposed By-Laws and Rules of Procedure for the Montcalm County Board of Commissioners.

Moved by Commissioner Johnston, supported by Commissioner Mahar to approve and adopt the Montcalm County Board of Commissioners By-Laws and Rules of Procedure pending any changes that need to be make as a results of moving to a Committee of the Whole structure. Motion carried.

Moved by Commissioner Petersen, supported by Commissioner Beach to correct **RESOLUTION 2020-12**, which was adopted on December 14, 2020, to remove page 3 and update the current COVID numbers:

Whereas, on Tuesday, March 10, 2020, Governor Whitmer declared a State of Emergency in the State of Michigan as a result of multiple positive cases of COVID-19; and

Whereas, the first case in Montcalm County was identified on March 12, 2020; and

Whereas, 2839 residents have tested positive in Montcalm County, and 69 people have died since; and

Whereas, the Montcalm County Emergency Operations Plan has been duly activated and departments, agencies, and government offices therein have been coordinating a county-wide response to the COVID-19 threat in accordance with the mandates of the Orders and Directives issued by Governor Whitmer and staff; and

Whereas, Montcalm County, in partnership with the State of Michigan, the Mid-Michigan District Health Department, and all governmental units within Montcalm County must maximize efforts to slow the spread of the COVID-19 virus and ensure, insofar as possible, that residents in Montcalm County take preventative measures to lower their risk and to share information with their friends, families, and coworkers; and

Whereas, we are requiring that all necessary measures be taken to address this ongoing threat of widespread infection and any and all issues arising as a result of the COVID-19 threat; and

Whereas, this action is being taken to protect the public health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Montcalm County.

Now, therefore be it resolved, in accordance with the Michigan Emergency Management Act of 1976, we are declaring a Local State of Emergency within the boundaries of Montcalm County, Michigan, effective at 12:01 on Tuesday, January 5, 2021; to continue until February 28, 2021 or until further action by the County Board of Commissioners.
