Definitions & Fees for Iredell County

Iredell County residents are required to display a decal for use of the site

- A. **Brush & Yard Waste:** *Included are items such as old firewood, clean leaves, grass clippings, shrubbery, limbs and cut trees under 8 inch diameter and no longer than 8 feet. No stumps of any size will be accepted. Loads larger than a secure pickup load will be directed to the Twin Oaks facility.*
Fee: *No Charge*
- A. **Commercial/Industrial Waste:** *All waste generated from factories, restaurants, businesses, churches and any other institutions.*
Fee: *\$41.00 per ton PLUS \$10/ton transportation fee*
- B. **Construction and Demolition Waste:** *Consists of wood, windows, vinyl siding, sheetrock, insulation, paneling, cabinets, fixtures, carpeting, flooring, or any material from construction or remodeling activities. Concrete, asphalt, brick, block, dirt, shingles, gravel and rocks will not be accepted at this facility. Large loads and unacceptable materials will be directed to the Twin Oaks facility. No C&D waste will be accepted after 6 p.m.*
Fee: *\$41 per ton PLUS \$10/ton transportation fee*
- C. **CRT (Cathode Ray Tube) TV's and Monitors:** *Cathode ray tubes or CRT television and computer monitors can be identified as the older picture tube units. These are banned from the landfill and are required to be recycled by state law.*
Fee: *\$10 per unit*
- D. **Household:** *Materials generated by the day to day housekeeping activities of a single family residential unit; including kitchen waste, food packaging, clothing, toys, floor sweepings and furniture. There will be no charge for these materials for residents that have paid the Solid Waste Availability Fee.*
- E. **North Carolina SW Disposal Tax:** *A \$2.00 per ton disposal tax will be added to all weight landfilled in the State of North Carolina.*
- F. **Recycled Materials:** *Consists of glass, aluminum cans, steel cans, mixed paper, cardboard, plastic, motor oil, anti-freeze, batteries and scrap metal. Must be source separated.*
Fee: *No charge*

- G. **Special Handling Fee:** *A one-time fee of the price per ton will be added to the tipping fee for any material disposed of that requires assistance with a piece of equipment to unload.*
Fee: \$41
- H. **Tires:** *Homeowners are granted free disposal of five (5) tires **off the rim** per year. Any tires on the rim will be assessed a fee.*
Fee: \$125/ton off-rim, \$200/ton on-rim
- I. **White Goods:** *Consists of refrigerators, stoves, freezers, air conditioners, hot water heaters, washers, dryers and water coolers. Must be kept separate from MSW.*
Fee: *No charge*
All White Goods Must Be Free of Food & All Other Waste Before Disposal.

All incoming loads are required by NC State law to be covered or secured.

Businesses are encouraged to call the Solid Waste Facility at (704) 663-5314 with questions or concerns about any item for disposal.

NC State permit does not allow out of county waste to be accepted at any of our facilities. All accepted waste must be generated from within the county.

ITEMS NOT ACCEPTED AT THIS FACILITY

- *No animals (required to be disposed of at the Twin Oaks facility)*
- *No asbestos*
- *No pallets*
- *No shingles*
- *No burnt wood, trash or ashes*
- ***No trailers over 10' in length or double loads will be accepted. All trailers over 10' in length will be directed to the Twin Oaks Location***
