



# HOW TO ACTIVATE THE SPLASH PAD?

Did you arrive at the splash pad during operating hours and notice the water is not on? No need to worry! Wave your hand over the water sensor (pictured below), and the splash pad should kick on. Still not working? It could be related to any of the following.










#### > Pet Hair

We know your furry one may want to join in on the fun, but please refrain from allowing your pet to play on the splash pad. Pet hair will quickly clog the system, causing the splash pad to turn off automatically.





#### Chemical Imbalance

If the splash pad water reaches a low chlorine amount, the splash pad will automatically shut off until the proper chlorine level is achieved. It may take 5 - 30 minutes for the appropriate chlorine levels to reached. Once the water chemical level is back to normal, the splash pad will turn on automatically.





### Report an Issue


Have you tried to activate the splash pad to no avail? Please let the Concessions Stand Staff know. If the Concessions Stand is closed, report the issue at MooresvilleNC.gov/LibertyPark. A splash pad expert will arrive soon after a problem is reported to check for clogs and chemical imbalances.





#### Please Note

Not all of the splash pad water spouts work at the same time. In order to optimize water quality, the splash pad spouts are grouped into zones. Every 15 minutes, the current zone will shut off, and a new one will commence.





## Friendly Reminders

For your safety, please follow all posted rules and regulations. It is important to remember that

- 1. Proper swim attire is required
- 2. Anyone 12 or under must be accompanied by an adult
- 3. Play is at your own risk
