ICATS Demand Response now available for residents

The Iredell County Area Public Transit System (ICATS) has begun Demand Response service for all residents of Iredell County ages 16 and up for \$1 per passenger. Demand Response service is scheduled pick-up and return transportation, and reservations must be made at least 48 hours in advance by calling ICATS at 704-873-9393 (press option 5).

In order to schedule a ride, callers must provide the name, address and telephone number of the passenger, as well as the time and date for pick-up, the address of the destination, and the return time. Callers should also detail if the rider has an assistive device such as a wheelchair, and if a personal care attendant will be joining them.

Please call the ICATS dispatch office if you are running late for your scheduled pick-up, as the vehicle will only wait up to 5 minutes after its arrival before proceeding to its next stop. Additionally, if you need to cancel your scheduled trip, please call at least two hours before the trip (trips before 8 a.m. must be cancelled the previous day). Trips that are not cancelled according to policy can eventually lead to a suspension of services.
