ASPIRE OF WNY	<i>ASPIRE OF WNY</i> provides a wide range of programs and services to children with disabilities and their families from the earliest possible diagnosis. The professional staff are trained, certified and licensed in their respective disciplines. The center offers early intervention services to promote an infant's development. Families participate with an interdisciplinary team in the assessment of the infant's abilities to meet identified needs. For infants who are medically fragile, a home-based program is available for more direct intervention.
Bornhava	<i>BORNHAVA</i> has an early intervention program for children birth to three years of age that have developmental delays. Evaluations and services are provided either at home or at the center. Together parents and staff design an Individualized Family Service Plan to address a child's specific area of need, including language and communication skills, motor, cognitive, behavior and self help skills. Children are seen at home by teachers and/or appropriate therapists or at the center and groups are available for parents alone or with their child.
Buffalo Hearing & Speech Center (BHSC)	<i>BUFFALO HEARING & SPEECH CENTER's</i> experienced and caring staff work together to provide special education and therapeutic services through the New York State Early Intervention Program. Evaluations are conducted in one of our school or clinic sites throughout the Western NY area. Our highly trained professionals specialize in evaluating children with <u>hearing loss and/or visual impairments</u> . Our dedicated and skilled staff is focused on the mission of improving the quality of life for children and their families.
Cantalician Center For Learning	The <i>CANTALICIAN CENTER</i> provides Early Intervention evaluations (CORES and Supplemental evaluations) and therapy services for children in their homes or daycare setting. Speech Therapy, Education services, Occupational Therapy and Physical Therapy Services are available. Cantalician Center is a provider approved by the New York State Department of Health.
