# OFFICE FOR THE AGING BUDGET MODIFICATION – ACCEPTANCE OF PARTNERSHIP IN INNOVATION FOR OLDER ADULTS GRANT

WHEREAS, the Niagara County Office for the Aging (NCOFA) provides community-based services to help older adults remain active and independent in the community, and

WHEREAS, the NCOFA receives various recurring and one-time state and federal grants each year to fund a portion of these services provided, and

WHEREAS, the NCOFA, in partnership with the Niagara County Office of Mental Health and Northpointe Council successfully applied and received the Partnership In Innovation For Older Adults (PIOA) Grant, a five-year, \$963,489 grant that begins on January 1, 2017 and will serve Niagara County individuals who are 55 years or older whose ability to remain safe and independent in the community is at risk due to mental health and/or substance abuse concerns, and

WHEREAS, the funding NCOFA receives through the PIOA grant will allow this office to fund one of our existing FT Case Manager- Senior Services to devote one half of their time, and support all of our operations in order to be an integral partner in the PIOA project and create a strong, connected network of behavioral health, peer, and aging service providers, as well as leverage other existing supports to meet with needs of At-Risk Older Adults, helping them to not only remain safe in the community, but helping them to flourish by remaining connected with medical, behavioral health, and non-medical supports in the community, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the department is given authorization to accept the grant increase with the effectuation of the following budget modifications:

RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF COMPLETE REMOVAL OF MATERIALS TEMPORARILY BURIED AT THE LAKE ONTARIO ORDINANCE WORKS (L.O.O.W.), MODEL CITY, N.Y.
WHEREAS, in the late 1940's the United States Government operated a site for the production Trinitrotoluene (T.N.T.) for war purposes at the Model City site on Balmer Road in the Towns of Porter a Lewiston, N.Y., and
WHEREAS, in ensuing years these lands were also used for production of other toxic and radioacti materials, which were subsequently consolidated and buried there for future disposition, and
WHEREAS, this Legislature along with the citizens of Niagara County have on many occasions enact resolutions requesting complete removal of these radioactive and dangerous materials away from the area remove the threat of serious health conditions which could present themselves in the event of leakage exposure, and
WHEREAS, the mere existence of this burial ground is detrimental to the health, economic vitality a desirability for business and residential improvements as well as reducing property values in this beautiful rule environment adjoining a great water resource, the Niagara River and Lake Ontario, and
WHEREAS, the issue of disposition is long overdue, and the Niagara County government and popular are unanimous in agreement with the US Army Corps of Engineers best recommendation to pursue Alternation 4, Excavation and Off Site Removal to address the area of concern (AOC) of the Occidental Chemic Corporation Property, now, therefore, be it
RESOLVED, on behalf of the citizens of Niagara County, this Legislature sincerely requests that t actions described in the above Whereas be carried out at the earliest and safest time available, and be it further
