# EMERGENCY SERVICES – AMBULANCE DIVISION AUTHORIZING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A PROGRAM TO TRANSITION EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIAN CC'S TO PARAMEDIC WITHIN NIAGARA COUNTY

WHEREAS, New York State Bureau of EMS and the State EMS Council voted in December 2023 to move forward with the sunset of the NYS EMT-Critical Care (EMT-CC) starting on July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2027, and

WHEREAS, all currently certified NYS EMT-CC shall expire at 0000 hours on July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2027 and will be automatically recertified at that time at an advanced level (AEMT) for the duration of their current cycle, and

WHEREAS, the County of Niagara has recognized the reduction in certified personnel and volunteers to staff and respond to the citizens of Niagara County thus creating a need to assist any volunteer firefighter, volunteer EMS provider or a career firefighter from one of the three career fire departments to upgrade their level of care to Paramedic from Critical Care, and

WHEREAS, the Niagara County Legislature and Niagara County EMS recognizes the importance of assisting these Critical Care providers with the ability to bridge to Paramedic for our county residents and help stimulate the shortage of Paramedics within Niagara County, and

WHEREAS, the Niagara County Legislature has identified the importance of establishing funding to assist any volunteer firefighter, volunteer EMS provider or a career firefighter from one of the three career fire departments with the Critical Care to Paramedic bridge program approved by the New York State Department of Health Bureau of EMS between April 2024 and the sunset of the Critical Care program July 1st 2027, and

WHEREAS, the approximate upfront cost for the program per student is \$3,300.00 with Niagara County having approximately 35 providers at the Critical Care level thus costing the County \$115,500.00 to enhance the provider level, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Niagara County Legislature, determines the importance of assisting Critical Care members of any volunteer firefighter, volunteer EMS provider or a career firefighter from one of the three career fire departments bridge to Paramedic through the Northwell Health NYS approved program, and be it further.

RESOLVED, that this resolution shall establish a funding line to assist the agencies with reimbursement of costs for sending members to the NYS Northwell Health bridge program, and be it further,

RESOLVED, that the County of Niagara will utilize funds from the Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Fund, a part of the American Rescue Plan Act, and be it further

WHEREAS, Section 1, Item (n), paragraph a of subdivision 2 of Section 11-0907 of the Environmental Conservation Law, as added by Section 1 of chapter 243 of the Laws of 2017, allowed for the County of Orleans to hunt deer using a pistol, shotgun, muzzle loading firearm, rifle or long bow, and

THE COUNTY OF NIAGARA

WHEREAS, Section 2, Item (1) of paragraph a of subdivision 2 of section 11-0907 of the Environmental Conservation Law as added by Section 1 of Chapter 243 of the Laws of 2018 allowed for the County of Orleans to hunt deer and bear by pistol, shotgun, crossbow, muzzle loading firearm, rifle or long bow only, and

WHEREAS, legislation has been introduced in the New York State Senate adding the County of Niagara to the Environmental Conservation Law authorizing hunting big game by rifle, and

WHEREAS, Niagara County has a long, proud tradition of supporting outdoor activities, wildlife conservation and all types of hunting, and

WHEREAS, the Niagara County Gun Owners' Rights Advisory Panel has recommended that to further enhance the hunting experience in Niagara County, the use of rifles for big game hunting should be permissible as already allowed in Orleans County and other Counties across the State, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Niagara County Legislature supports Senate Bill No. 8382 and Assembly Bill No. 9130 amending the Environmental Conservation Law in relation to authorizing hunting big game by rifle in the County of Niagara, and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Clerk of the Niagara County Legislature is hereby authorized and directed to execute the proper Home Rule documents and immediately forward them to the New York State Legislature.
