APPROVAL OF VOTING MACHINE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE COUNTY OF NIAGARA AND THE NIAGARA FALLS, LOCKPORT, NORTH TONAWANDA, LEW-PORT, NEWFANE, NIAGARA WHEATFIELD, ROY-HART, STARPOINT, SCHOOL DISTRICTS AND THE VILLAGE OF YOUNGSTOWN (§3-224, NEW YORK STATE ELECTION LAW)

WHEREAS, the Niagara Falls, Lockport, North Tonawanda, Lew-port, Newfane, Niagara Wheatfield, Roy-Hart, Starpoint School Districts and the Village of Youngstown will be conducting an election on May 16, 2023 and requires the use of the Niagara County Board of Elections voting equipment in connection with this election and

WHEREAS, the Niagara County Attorney's Office has prepared a formal agreement for use between the County of Niagara and the Niagara Falls, Lockport, North Tonawanda, Lew-port, Newfane, Niagara Wheatfield, Roy-Hart, Starpoint School District and the Village of Youngstown, which has been fully approved by the District, a copy of which has been filed with the Clerk of the Legislature, and

WHEREAS, time is of the essence in connection with the approvals by the Niagara County Legislature and

WHEREAS, under the terms of the agreement the County will provide, and be reimbursed for voting machine preparation, programming, and packaging of the voting machine and all necessary Niagara County personnel: the District, among other things, shall furnish at its expense, election custodians and inspectors and also insurance in form, content and amounts as approved by the Niagara County Attorney, and

WHEREAS, the final written agreement between the parties is subject to the review and approval by the parties' respective legal counsel, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that pursuant to the provisions of §3-224 of New York State Election Law, the Chair of the Niagara County Legislature and the Niagara County Election Commissioners are authorized and directed to execute and deliver an agreement, in substantially the form of agreement now filed with the Clerk of the Legislature between and among the County of Niagara, the Niagara County Election Commissioners and the Niagara Falls, Lockport, North Tonawanda, Lew-port, Newfane, Niagara Wheatfield, Roy-Hart, Starpoint School Districts and the Village of Youngstown for the provision, by the County of Niagara, of sufficient voting equipment, including the programming thereof, to the Niagara Falls, Lockport, North Tonawanda, Lew-port, Newfane, Niagara Wheatfield, Roy-Hart, Starpoint School Districts and the Village of Youngstown in connection with any election scheduled to be held during 2023, and be it further

RESOLVED, that the execution and delivery of this equipment, is subject to the approval of the Board of the Niagara Falls, Lockport, North Tonawanda, Lew-port, Newfane, Niagara Wheatfield, Roy-Hart, Starpoint School Districts and the Village of Youngstown, and the review and approval of the Niagara County Attorney's Office and counsel to the Niagara Falls, Lockport, North Tonawanda, Lew-port, Newfane, Niagara Wheatfield, Roy-Hart, Starpoint School Districts and the Village of Youngstown, and be it further

# NIAGARA COUNTY SUPPORT FOR NYSAC AND NYSCOPA PROPOSALS TO IMPROVE PROBATION AND ALTERNATIVES TO INCARCERATION PROGRAMS IN NEW YORK STATE.

WHEREAS, County Probation Departments are an integral part of the Criminal Justice System and operate within the legal framework of the Criminal Procedure Law, the Penal Law and the Family Court Act, and

WHEREAS, it is the mission of probation to protect the community through intervention in the lives of those under supervision by facilitating compliance with court orders and serving as a catalyst for positive change, and

WHEREAS, state funding for probation was drastically reduced between 1990 and 2022 from a 46.5 percent State share in 1990 to less than 10 percent in 2022, putting a huge strain on counties and cost to county property taxpayers, and

WHEREAS, at the same time there have been increases in the number of mandated programs and services county probation departments are required to provide, and

WHEREAS, the New York State Council of Probation Administrators (NYSCOPA), representing New York State Probation Directors, Administrators, and Commissioners has diligently worked with the New York State Association of Counties (NYSAC) and State leaders to bring more awareness to the important work that Probation does to protect the public, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Niagara County Legislature supports proposals put forward by NYSAC to immediately enact statutory and regulatory changes that improve Probation and Alternatives to Incarceration in the following ways:

- 1) In response to raise the age legislation:
- a) Mandate that the state's evidence-based criteria should account for existing local best practice programs.
- b) Allow probation the ability to make an application to Family Court for a temporary order of protection as a part of the adjustment process.
- c) Authorize law enforcement agencies to issue appearance tickets if deemed appropriate by the arresting officer, instead of physical arrest, when adolescent offenders and juvenile offenders are charged with most D felonies.
- d) Allow law enforcement agencies to deliver adolescent offenders and juvenile offenders to be held in detention facilities after hours without a securing order until the youth part is in session.

- 2) Establish a dedicated funding stream through Division of Criminal Justice Services (DCJS) Office of Probation and Correctional Alternatives (OPCA) for 100 percent of all local probation costs including but not limited to probation personnel and evidence-based programming associated with raise the age legislation.
- 3) Eliminate the requirement of a sentence of a conditional discharge or probation for Leandra's Law cases when a defendant has been sentenced to a definite jail term or a term of imprisonment.
- 4) That local probation departments receive reimbursement for 100 percent of all pre-trial services cost including but not limited to probation personnel associated with bail reform.
- 5) That the executive chamber and the Office of Children and Families Services (OCFS) work towards transitioning some of the closed OCFS or department of correctional and community supervision facilities to accommodate the lack of specialized secure detention beds as well as allowing county consortiums to open specialized secure detention facilities if desired.
