1. The County of Niagara is hereby divided into thirty-one (31) districts bounded and described in the descriptions and maps attached hereto and made a part of this Local Law.

2. The legislative powers of the County of Niagara shall be exercised by the County Legislature.

3. The County Legislature shall be composed of thirty-one (31) members who shall be elected, one from each of the thirty-one (31) legislative districts set forth herein.

4. The County Legislature shall have and exercise all powers and duties of the County, all powers and duties heretofore or hereafter conferred or imposed on the former Board of Supervisors or other county legislative body by applicable law, and all powers necessarily incidental thereto. All provisions of applicable law wherein powers and duties are conferred upon the legislative body of a county of the State of New York shall be construed to refer to the county legislature of the County of Niagara.

5. The County Legislature shall have the powers and duties authorized by law, and the term of office for County Legislator shall be fixed at two (2) years.
