A local law increasing the salaries of certain county officials

1. The salary of the County Treasurer shall be increased in the sum of \$1,000, effective 45 days after adoption of this Local Law. Effective January 1, 1972, the annual salary of the County Treasurer shall be \$16,000.
2. The salary of the County Judge and County & Surrogate Judge shall be increased in the sum of \$1,750, effective 45 days after adoption of this Local Law. Effective January 1, 1972, the annual salary of the County Judge and County & Surrogate Judge shall be \$30,750.
3. The salary of the Family Court Judge shall be increased in the sum of \$1,750, effective 45 days after adoption of this Local Law. Effective January 1, 1972, the annual salary of the Family Court Judge shall be \$30,750.
4. The salary of the Public Defender shall be increased in the sum of \$2,000, effective 45 days after adoption of this Local Law. Effective January 1, 1972, the annual salary of the Public Defender shall be \$12,000.
5. The salary of the Commissioner of Social Services shall be increased in the sum of \$1,000, effective 45 days after adoption of this Local Law. Effective January 1, 1972, the annual salary of the Commissioner of Social Services shall be \$19,000.

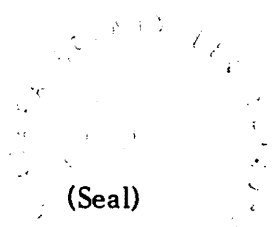
