The salary of the County Attorney shall be increased in the sum of \$1,624 effective 45 days after adoption of this Local Law with a lump sum installment to be paid as soon as possible for the past services rendered from January 1, 1985 and the balance of the increase to be paid in equal installments over the remaining pay periods. Effective retroactive to January 1, 1985, the annual salary of the County Attorney shall be \$34,099.
- 2.
