An Estate Bill of Sale acknowledges that the Seller (Surviving Spouse/Executor) is transferring ownership of the firearm(s) to the Buyer.
The surviving spouse/executor of the estate must provide the Pistol Permit Office with the decedent's pistol permit, a copy of the death certificate and proof of executorship.

Buyer/Purchaser must obtain a valid NICS background check by an authorized NYS Gun Dealer unless the Buyer is an immediate family member. Immediate family members – including “step” are: mother, father, sister, brother, children, spouse/domestic partner.
