APPROVAL OF PUBLIC HEARING
LOCAL LAW RE INCREASE IN THE MAXIMUM ALTERNATIVE VETERAN'S
EXEMPTION

WHEREAS, Legislator John Tylec and the Finance Committee recommend the adoption of the following Local Law:

A Local Law of the County of Niagara New York, for the year 1997, in relation to the Alternative Veteran's Exemption from Real Property Taxation under Section 458-a of the Real Property Tax Law (RPTL) of the State of New York, and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on October 21, 1997 at 7:30 p.m. in the Legislative Chambers, Courthouse, Lockport, New York, on said Local Law, and

WHEREAS, two persons appeared to speak on said Local Law, and

WHEREAS, no amendment(s) was (were) made to said Local Law, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that a Local Law of the County of Niagara New York, for the year 1997, in relation to the Alternative Veteran's Exemption from Real Property Taxation under Section 458-a of the Real Property Tax Law (RPTL) of the State of New York be enacted by the County Legislature of the County of Niagara, New York, as follows:

Section 1. The purpose of this law is to increase the maximum exemption allowable in Real Property Tax Law, Section 458-a(2) a, b, and c to eighteen thousand dollars (\$18,000), twelve thousand dollars (\$12,000), and sixty thousand dollars (\$60,000), respectively.

Section 2. This local law shall take effect immediately upon its filing with the Secretary of State and shall be applicable to all 1998 assessment rolls prepared on or after January 1, 1998.
