Steve Eosco, RSVP Veteran Volunteer speaks on MA Volunteer Day at State House

RSVP 'Rides for Veterans' driver was invited to represent MA Senior Corps on Tuesday, April 25 to share his vital work with volunteer organizations, enthusiasts and state legislators. Steve is a Marine Corps Veteran (active 1969-72) who lives with his wife Toni in Norwood, MA. During the Vietnam War, he was deployed with the Marine Detachment on the Aircraft Carrier USS Shangri-La to the Tonkin Gulf off the Coast of Vietnam. Steve has been volunteering as a 'Rides for Vets' Driver for the past 2 1/2 years. He has given over 50 Rides to Veterans for medical appointments logging in 980 miles and over 80 hours of service time including supporting his Veteran riders during hospital visits. At the podium, Steve shared many stories which reflected the mutual and personal connections made with his Veteran riders.. He concluded by saying: *'In volunteering to provide rides for veterans, I form pleasant relationships that enhance that sense of community and I provide a ride that is safe, compassionate and friendly. I am grateful to RSVP because through the organization I can give a little bit of my time back to veterans who gave us so much more of themselves. I get much satisfaction and great pride in volunteering for this program. I remain, "Semper Fidelis".'*
