3c) Food Safety Reports

1. Crushed Peppers: Inspection took place yesterday and pest control has decreased. Will remain on weekly treatments.

2. New Food Establishment List

Oasis Caribbean Cuisine and Old Mill Grille have opened since the last Board Meeting. Cheff'n & Eetinn @ the Cakery and Melissa's Catering have submitted paperwork to the Health Department but has not opened yet.

3. Food Establishment Inspection Report: January 8, 2019-February 1, 2019

Olivadi's: No hot water at hand sinks and closed for lunch. Hot water was restored at 5pm and reopened for business. Checking water temperature has been added to opening checklist. Add to update list.

Orange Leaf: Needs to recertify in food safety management. 30 days to comply.

Benchmark: New PIC has been assigned to facility. Needs to submit FMC and Allergen paperwork.

Café Paprika: Bags of onions stored on floor.

Same Old Place: Items were corrected at re-inspection.

Mak's Roast Beef: Sanitarian will ask for more detailed notes on pest control reports. Add to update list.

Pizzeria Bruno's: Re-inspection scheduled for the 28th. Pipe under the sink has been repaired.

Victoria's Café: Re-inspection has been scheduled.

After Review of the restaurant inspection report the following establishments are to be placed on the update list: **Olivadi's, Mak's Roast Beef**

4. **DIRECTOR'S REPORT**

4a) **Public Health 3.0**

Public Health 3.0 is a strategy for health departments to address public health. It focuses on improving health by addressing the Social Determinants of Health, such as access to healthy food, safe housing, education, healthy environment, safety neighborhoods, etc. Research has shown that the Social Determinates of Health account for eighty percent of the factors that impact health. Social Determinants of Health include socioeconomic factors such as economic stability, and education; physical environment such as parks, playgrounds, transportation; and health behaviors such as smoking, and diet/nutrition.

The way we address these factors is through engaging multiple sectors and community partners as we have with Impact Norwood and Minds Matter coalitions.
