

Ellis Playground

Off Codman Road and bounded by US Route 1 is open space known as Ellis Playground. This park has sports and play areas, as well as a small network of trails for the surrounding neighborhood.

The land is within the Fowl Meadow Area of Critical Environmental Concern (ACEC). The town of Norwood developed the Ellis Avenue Wellfields in 1912, and they served as the town's primary water supply until the 1950s. Norwood retains ownership through the Water Services Department.

Cattails are plentiful, as well as skunk cabbage and other wet-loving vegetation. Hawks have been spotted, as well as orioles, red-wing blackbirds, and catbirds.

Pets are welcomed but must remain on leash.

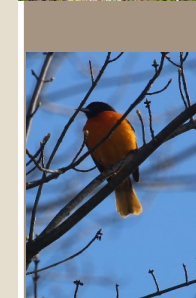
No alcoholic beverages.

Ellis Playground Trail Map

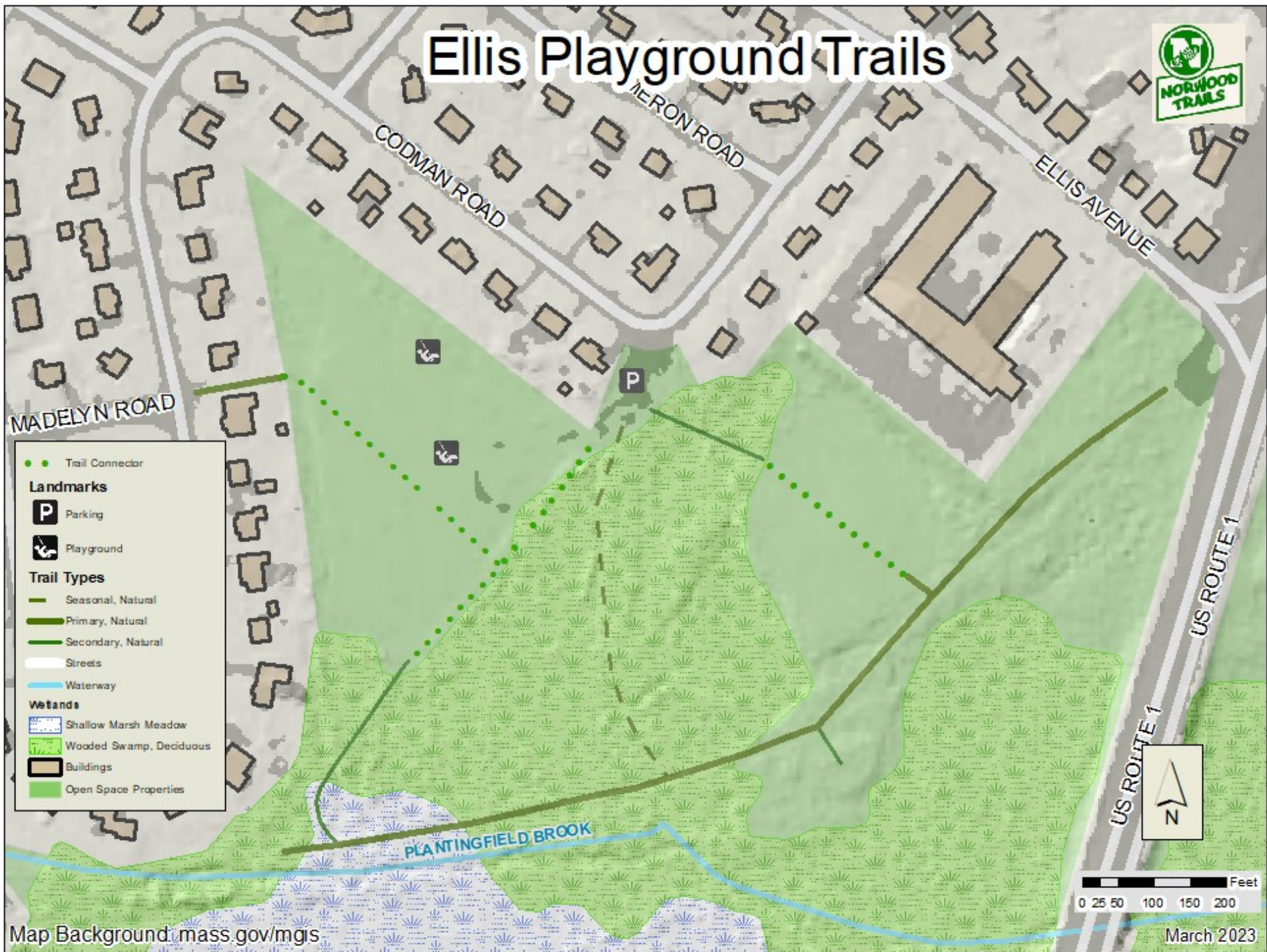
