3. OLD BUSINESS

3a) Update of COVID-19

There has been a decrease in number of cases across the state. The total confirmed cases in Norwood are 570 and we have had two new confirmed cases this week. The Health Department investigates confirmed and probable cases. The community testing program at Norwood Hospital is still available. The breakdown of cases by town is posted on the state website every week.

3b) Impact Norwood Program Director Report

Impact Norwood has hosted a number of webinars over the past few months. Topics have included helping parents raise their teens in a difficult world, how food impacts the mood and how to promote positive mental health during this time. All webinars are on impactnorwood.org. The youth coalition has been meeting virtually and will start the positive community norms campaign soon. The Metrowest youth health survey will start again in the fall.

3c) Sanitarian Report:

Covid Response

The Sanitarian has been working on pandemic enforcement with the local establishments including discussing the new standards issued by the State. He has visited most of the outdoor dining so far and is hoping to get back to routine inspections soon. Indoor dining does start today as part of phase 2 part 2. Tables must be 6 feet apart inside similar to the outdoor regulations.

New Food Establishment Report

Sayar Market, As Good as it Gets, Cousin's Maine Lobster and Norwood Golden Bull have opened since the last Board Meeting. Simple Nutrition has submitted paperwork to the Health Department but has not opened yet.
