Applicant: Mike Argiros of Alexander Argiros A Trs Representative: Sam Malafronte of Solli Engineering, LLC  
Project Description: Replication of an isolated vegetated wetland cleared in violation of the Norwood Wetland Protection Bylaw. Had requested continuance to this, August 23, 2023, meeting.

Applicant: Town of Norwood Representative: Amy Ball, Horsley Witten  
Project Description: The project involves the construction of a new, replacement in-ground outdoor swimming pool, splash pad, pool deck, pavilion, and mechanical/storage building, within areas jurisdictional under the MA WPA and the Norwood Wetlands Bylaw, to address code compliance issues such as a pool leak, failing pump room, and outdated pool equipment, as well as to better serve the Norwood population across age groups and abilities.
