Mr. Raymond: What's going on with Norwood Airport? I'm getting lots of neighborhood complaints from Winfield/Rock Streets over the last week. Yesterday--Monday May 15--over 80 overflights, now extending into the evening. There were over 30 flights from 5pm to 7:43pm, with a neighbor texting me 2 videos to show how low and loud they were--dangerously low. Today, starting @8:48am (which seems to be the starting time now, which we appreciate) until noon, there were over 50 overflights and I've already heard complaints. The day isn't over yet. We'd appreciate an update at the NAC May meeting...thanks...Diane Wiffin

Mr. Raymond: Please add Thursday and Friday, May 11 and May 12 to the Winfield/Rock Streets neighborhood noise complaints, with @100 overflights over those 2 days. That's 3 days in a row with the planes flying even lower and louder, very dangerous. No diversions. We're looking forward to an update at the May Norwood Airport Commission meeting...Diane Wiffin

Mr. Raymond: Another noisy day for the Winfield/Rock Streets neighborhood as over 100 airplanes flew low, loud and divebombing from @9:35am to @7:56pm on Wednesday, May 10. The planes get lower and louder as the day progresses, and they are now flying as the sun sets @8pm. Including the noise complaints below, we're estimating we're now at @7500 planes flying overhead since we started tracking the planes @June 2022. Our neighborhood is sure that the total would be higher if we hadn't been meeting with the Norwood Airport Commission since January 2023, so thank you for your efforts. We look forward to meeting with you at the May meeting...Diane Wiffin

Sunday May 7: from @1:25pm to 7:23pm there were @50 low, loud planes over Winfield/Rock Street.

Thursday April 27: A Rock Street neighbor filed a noise complaint with the FAA and copied me, but not Norwood Airport Commission, so I'm adding his noise complaint in this email. He indicates that from 8am on throughout the day there was a barrage of airplanes @5 minutes apart. This went on until @5pm, when it thankfully rained.
