Hi, Mark! When the Winfield/Rock neighborhood heard a plane flyover at 10am, then 10:30am on Sunday August 20, we didn't think the day was going to deteriorate. Then, from 10:48am until the last plane flyover at @7pm there was one flight school plane--with an occasional jet--after another, especially over Winfield Street. Having a plane start over Winfield Street, then turn (still over Winfield) to go over Coolidge, then Route 1, is still loud and disruptive. Total @50 overflights--no redirection. no adherence to the noise abatement letter you emailed to the pilots (see attached). The Winfield/Rock neighborhood attended monthly meetings with the Norwood Airport Commission from January to July (7 meetings) and a meeting with the pilots. There has been so much improvement--this has been a quiet summer--that the disruption on Sunday August 20 was especially disappointing. Hopefully, this day was a "one off" and a quiet summer and fall will continue...Diane Wiffin
