Mr. Raymond: Time for Airport Commissioners Michael Sheehan and John Corcoran to make a visit to Winfield Street when the planes are flying overhead--like today when over 100 of them were flying overhead, starting at @8:18am and continuing non-stop all day every few minutes until@6:29pm. (There were probably closer to @120-130 overflights as I was not available to count for 3 hours, and at one point we had 30 overflights in one hour.) How can we contact the Commissioners when we have a day like today? I see that my Winfield Street neighbor Linda Carroll said that the planes were flying over her house--she lives down the street from me so they must have started down there and continued their flight over my house. I could see them flying overhead on the same flight path over and over. No redirection, no variation. All day. Our Winfield/Rock Street neighborhood has had four meetings with the Airport Commission and we thought there would be some improvement, and there was. Until today. Very disappointing. Today was comparable to what we experienced during summer 2022, and we're hoping we're not heading back in that direction, rather than forward. I didn't see a construction update on the airport website, so why all the overflights? Please put us on the agenda for the April Airport Commission meeting, and perhaps we can get an update.
