For over 12 hours, from 7:12am to 7:18pm there were over 60 overflights, including jets, flying very low, very loud over the Winfield/Rock Streets neighborhood. This is now 1 1/2 years since these overflights have disrupted our neighborhood. We will be at the Norwood Airport Commission meeting on September 20--our 9th meeting, including a meeting with the pilots, who know that overflights over our neighborhood is an issue...Diane Wiffin

120 overflights from 8:55am all day, no let up, low, loud until 6:40pm on Sunday, September 17--a family and friends sunny day that couldn't be enjoyed outside or inside. Why are the overflights back in full force? Is construction not done yet? The Winfield/Rock neighborhood had 7 meetings with the Norwood Airport Commission from January to July, a meeting with the pilots, and saw a noise abatement letter to pilots to adhere to the signage on the runway to redirect flights from our neighborhood, the 120 overflights should not be happening. Is this going to be a Sunday thing--there were 50 overflights on Sunday, August 20; @25 on Sunday September 3 (from 2:22 to 4:46pm; a short period, lucky for us). We're looking forward to an update when we meet with the Norwood Airport Commission on September 20...Diane Wiffin
