Good afternoon, Mr. Raymond:

On Tuesday, April 11, 2023, between 10:15 am through and including 1:28 pm, there were 56 airplanes that flew over 251 Rock Street/Hilltop Gardens condominium complex. Quite a few of the fly overs were from the same planes, which I believe belong to flight schools operating out of Norwood Memorial Airport. I was not able to continue to record the times of the planes flying over 251 Rock Street/Hilltop Gardens during the rest of the afternoon, but they sounded like they were continuing at the same pace as noted below. I did file a noise complaint with the FAA.
