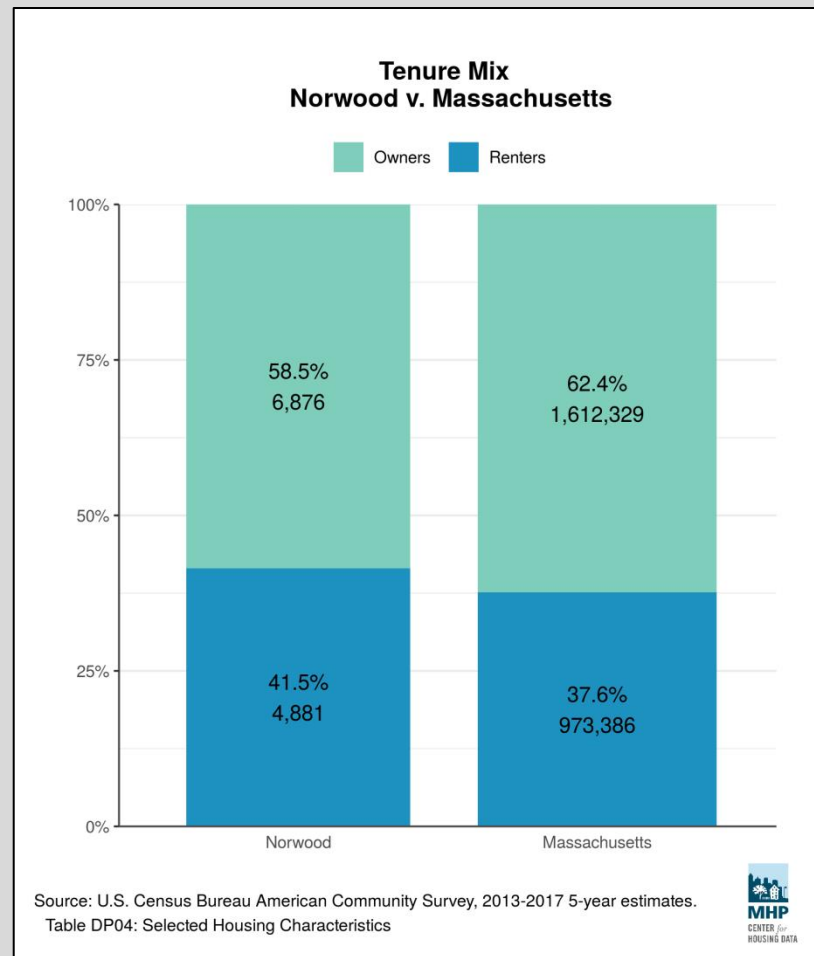

Norwood's age typology type: **Age Balanced**

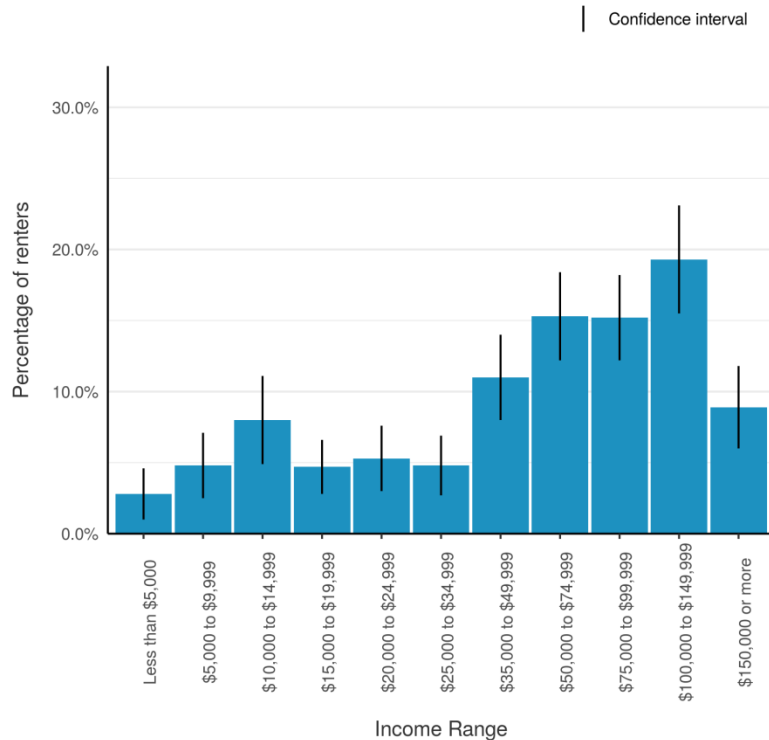

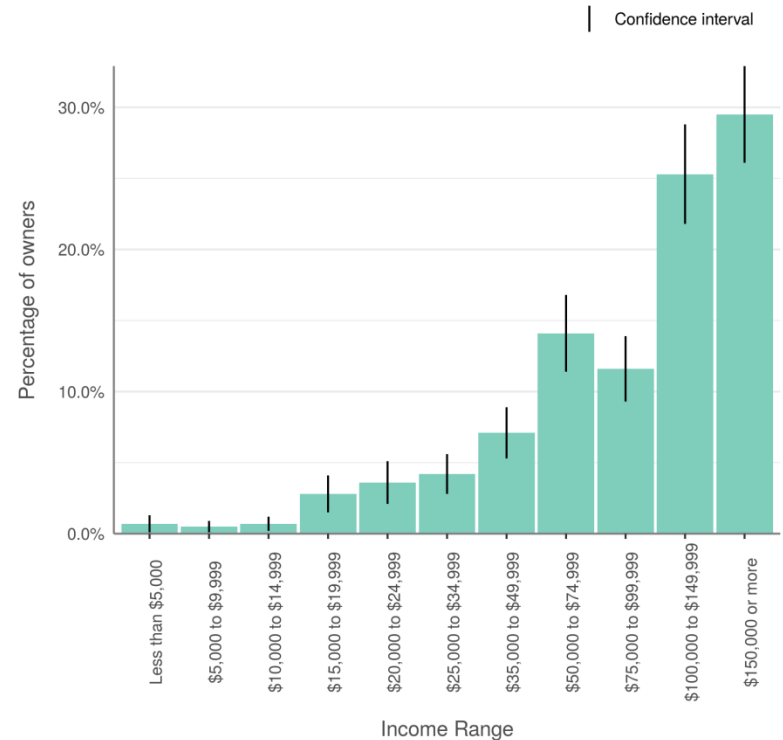

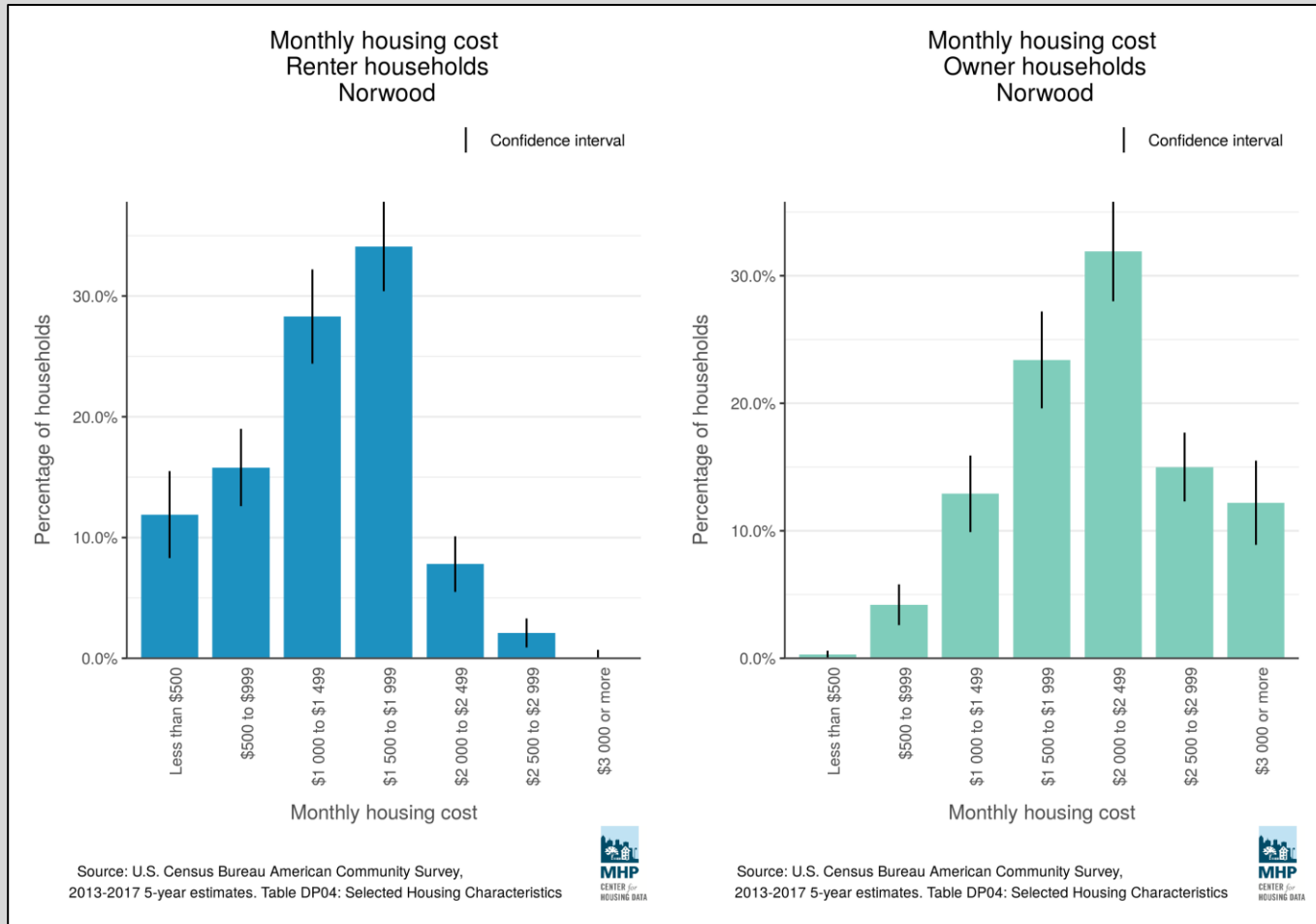

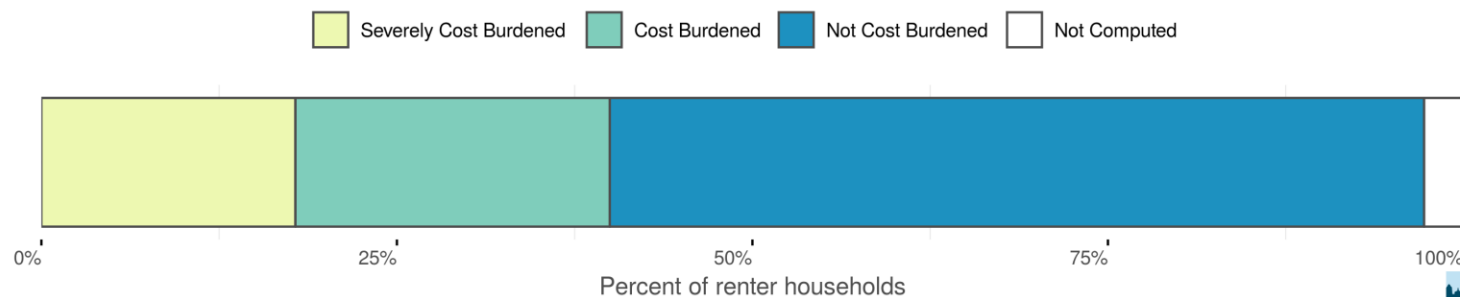

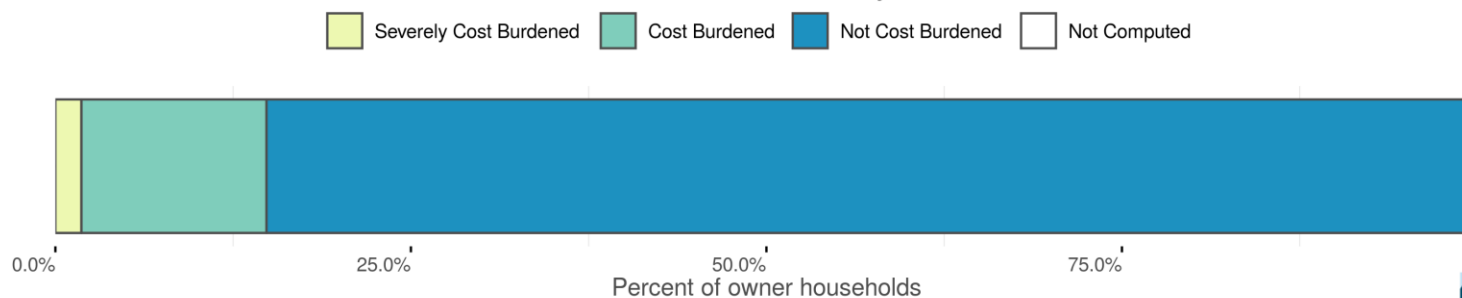
