

**Selectmen’s Meeting**

**July 15, 2021**

**Hybrid Meeting**

**Meeting is Recorded**

*Under Governor Baker’s emergency “Order Suspending Certain Provisions of the Open Meeting Law G.L. C. 30A, Section 20”, issued March 12, 2020 and in effect until termination of the State of Emergency: This meeting of the Board of Selectmen will be conducted hybrid model with Board meeting in person in the Selectmen’s Chambers in Town Hall, and all other participants joining remotely. The Meeting will be called to order by the Chairman at 2:30 P.M.*

**Present: Chairman Maloney, Vice Chairman Plasko, Selectman Hajjar, Selectman Lane, General Manager Tony Mazzucco, Chief George Morrice, Joe Collins, Christine Woodward**

*The meeting was convened at 2:30 PM on July 15th, 2021, in the Selectmen’s Chambers, Room 134 at Norwood Town Hall, 566 Washington Street, with Pledge of Allegiance and a moment of silent reflection.*

**Municipal Relief:**

Mr. Mazzucco presented three municipal relief transfers that need to be completed. They are as follows:

1. \$49,447 transferred from Debt Service to Medicare due to the school’s Summer payroll that was not factored in at Town Meeting.
2. \$18,547 transferred from Debt Service to Legal Expense. This year there were higher legal costs due to Forbes Hill and Norwood Airport litigation as well as collective bargaining costs.
3. \$64,739 transferred from Water/Sewer Salaries to DPW Salaries and Cemetery Salaries.

On motion of Selectman Hajjar, seconded by Selectman Plasko, the motion was approved unanimously.

**Reserve Fund Transfer:**

Chief Morrice is requesting a reserve fund transfer in the amount of \$18,500.00. This amount includes \$12,849.25 to pay various charges due to the country club incident of June 29, 2021 and \$5,488.04 to repair damage done to a large cabinet on Engine 5. Chief Morrice expects there to be another charge for the landscaping repair at the country club, however, the ground needs to dry before it can be done. On motion of Selectman Lane, seconded by Selectman Hajjar, the motion was approved unanimously.

Selectman Hajjar requested that the Land Use Regulations be added to the Agenda for the meeting in two weeks – scheduled for August 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2021.

On motion of Selectman Lane, seconded by Selectman Hajjar, the Board voted unanimously to adjourn.
