complete the punch list items. A request was submitted to FAA to de-scope Taxiway D from the
grant.

Southern Airways operations were also discussed. The settlement agreement regarding communication protocol meetings with BEH was discussed.

Administration Building

Throughout this period, in support of the administration building fit-out project, airport management has hosted and participated in weekly job meetings with the owner's project manager, general contractor, architects, and occasionally, sub-contractors. (These meetings are still held each Wednesday at 9 a.m.) Airport management also continues to work daily with the general contractor and its subs, architects, MassDOT, suppliers and other contractors allied to the project. For this period, in particular, special attention has been given to coordinating installation of the building's security and fire control systems, utility service, interior finishes and landscaping.

Permits, Extension Request

On 10/2, the Airport Manager (AM) met with the local Conservation Commission (Con Com) seeking approval of a request to extend two permits. These are needed for development of lease lots A,B,C. The permits were subsequently approved by the Con Com, with extensions to 12/31/21. See Attachments A-C.

- Informational Updates -

Office Lease

As of this writing, a completed (ready to move in) fit-out of the new administration building is still forthcoming. The AM has therefore asked *Flight Level* to continue the Airport Department's tenancy of the current office space through October.

Special Event Proposal

At *Flight Level's* request, the AM recently met to discuss the planning steps needed for *Flight Level* to hold a special event, pending Airport Commission approval. *Flight Level* has since crafted a special event proposal for review by the Commission. (This has been made available to the Commission under separate cover.) The event is tentatively set for 10/12.

We are pleased to present this Contract Amendment for professional engineering services for the above referenced project. This document amends our contract dated February 2108.

Additional Services that we provided on this project included construction engineering as related to the weather delays associated with record rainfall during the late fall 2018. This caused a delay of 30 calendar days for the project. Also, post construction monitoring will be deleted from the project to expedite project closeout. Post construction monitoring will be part of a separate grant.

ADDITIONAL SCOPE OF SERVICES

Task 1 - Construction Engineering

The additional construction engineering includes a second preconstruction conference, one additional change order, review revised project construction schedule, resident inspector support, one additional site visit and one additional pay application.

Task 2 - Post Construction Monitoring (Years 1 & 2)

Post construction monitoring which was included in amendment 1 will be deleted from the contract and will be part of a separate grant to reduce closeout time for the project.





INTRODUCTION & REQUEST FOR CONSENT

FlightLevel Norwood, LLC respectfully requests consent for its "Promotional Event" at the Norwood Memorial Airport on Saturday, October 12, 2019, between 4:00 pm and 10:00 pm. The purpose is to attract new business to the airport by showcasing FlightLevel's and the Airport's offerings. The details of the event follow.

INVITEES

Attendance will be by invitation-only, directed to based customers, local business leaders, representatives of private and corporate flight departments, charter and fractional jet owners and operators, high net worth individuals, and Town and Airport officials. Approximately 200 invitations will go out, with approximately 100 invitees expected to attend.

EVENT

Attendees will arrive first at FlightLevel's passenger terminal (Building 7) in the vicinity of the Airport's main "Gate 1" entrance. From there, they will be escorted by badged FlightLevel personnel to FlightLevel's Building 13, where the event will be held. There they will enjoy complimentary refreshments, live music (steel drum band), and meet with aviation professionals, FlightLevel and Town leaders, and other event attendees. They will lastly be escorted by badged FlightLevel personnel back to FlightLevel's terminal (Building 7), and depart the airport by air or land from there.

SECURITY

The event will be staffed throughout by badged FlightLevel employees, who will be positioned along the route from the Airport parking lot to Building 13. Both Officer Begley and Detective Green of the Norwood Police Department have been placed on notice. Officer Begley is FlightLevel's primary point of contact. NPD Officer Kevin McDonough participated in a pre-event inspection of the event site, and subject to the Airport Commission's oversight, did not believe a Police detail would be necessary. However, if the Airport Commission desires, Officer Begley will assign one.

NORWOOD FIRE DEPARTMENT

Lieutenant John Cody of the Norwood Fire Department has been fully briefed. He conducted a pre-event inspection of the event premises on September 27, 2019, and provided NFD's authorization for the event to proceed. NFD's primary concerns were: (1) that access to the airport and to the buildings on the airport be maintained and not blocked; (2) that exits to the buildings associated with the event be unobstructed and well lit.

NORWOOD BUILDING DEPARTMENT

Building Inspector Matthew Walsh has been fully briefed. He conducted a pre-event inspection of the event premises on September 27, 2019, and provided NBD's authorization for the event to proceed.

FOOD

The event will be catered by Roxy's Grilled Cheese, and Authentic Pad Thai d/b/a Yummy Pad Thai. Both have been issued temporary food permits for the event by the Norwood Board of Health.

ALCOHOL

Beer, wine and margaritas will be served in Building 13 by Barrel House Z and Rustic Spirits' professional staff bartenders. Both Barrel House Z and Rustic Spirits are licensed to sell and serve liquor in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, and because they, rather than FlightLevel will be catering the event, no special one-day liquor license will need to be issued to FlightLevel. However, the Board of Selectmen have been placed on notice, and a copies of the Notice Letter, together with copies of the alcoholic beverage licenses and TiPPS certifications have been provided to the Board of Selectmen and the Airport Manager.

INSURANCE

FlightLevel Norwood, LLC caries airport and aviation liability, including host liquor liability insurance in the amount of \$10,000,000 per occurrence. PARKING

Because the event will be an "open house," and attendees will arrive and depart throughout the course of the afternoon and evening, the Airport's public parking area will be sufficient. 
