Expedited Permitting

- Economic Development Incentive Program (EDIP) was established by the Mass Executive Office of Business Development
- The Town established the Vanderbilt Expedited Permitting District in 2009

Benefits of Expedited Permitting

Guarantees local permitting decisions in Expedited Permitting Districts within 180 days.

Provides a transparent and efficient process for permitting projects.

Increases visibility of our targeted development sites.

Benefits of Expedited Permitting

Provides certainty that all permit application will be acted upon within 180 days.


When companies are moving, expanding or building in a new location, they need certainty on the duration of the permitting process this is an important consideration in any build here vs elsewhere


Benefits of Expedited Permitting

- 42 parcels ranging in size from 1 acre to 28 acres




Vanderbilt 43D District Facts and Figures
