KEEP MERCURY OUT OF THE TRASH! IT'S THE LAW!

The following mercury containing items are BANNED from the trash. You must see the DPW attendant to drop off:

- ✓ FLUORESCENT STRAIGHT TUBES (2ft, 4ft and 8ft)
- ✓ COMPACT FLUORESCENTS (CFL'S)
- ✓ FLUORESCENT U TUBES
- ✓ FLUORESCENT ROUND TUBES
- ✓ HIGH INTENSITY BULBS (outdoor lighting, car head lights)
- ✓ BUTTON CELL BATTERIES (watches, cameras, calculators, hearing aids and personal organizers)
- ✓ THERMOMETERS, COOKING THERMOMETERS
- ✓ THERMOSTATS
- ✓ MERCURY SWITCHES
- ✓ ELEMENTAL MERCURY
- ✓ BLOOD PRESSURE UNITS, FLOW METERS, BAROMETERS

PLEASE NOTE: *Handle fluorescent bulbs by their base to avoid breakage.

*Do NOT tape fluorescent tubes together. *Place compact fluorescents in plastic Ziploc bag before leaving the house. *Handle with care. *See DPW Attendant to hand over mercury items.
