What can you do with SCRAP METALS?

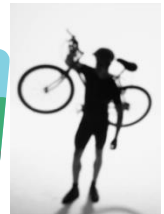
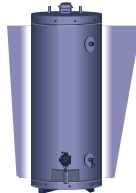
1. **Reuse**- if your scrap metal item is still in good condition sell it on craigslist.com, or ebay or list for free at freecycle.org. If you have wire hangers, bring back to dry cleaners.
2. **Allied Recycling** will pay you for your scrap metals, when you drop them off at their facility in Walpole. Call 508.668.8699
3. Drop off your scrap metals at the **Winter Street Composting Site**. Sat only. Permit required. Call DPW at 781.762.1240 for more info
4. Pay the town \$25 for **curbside pick up**. Call DPW at 781.762.1240 for more info.
5. Pack it up and drop it off on **Spring Recycle Day/Household Hazardous Waste Day, May 10th**. Call Board of Health for more info at 781.762.1240 re Household Hazardous Waste Day.

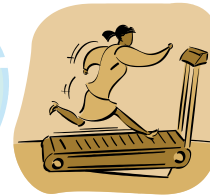
