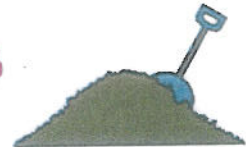


Per MA State Waste Ban Regulations **YARD & ORGANIC DEBRIS** cannot go in trash or recycle carts



## YARD DEBRIS OPTIONS:

1. **BACK YARD COMPOSTING**—Call Board of Health at 781.762.1240 X 176, if you would like to purchase a \$20 Earth Machine Composter. Or go to <http://eartheasy.com/yard-garden/composting> to look at various composters
2. **DROP OFF** yard debris at the town's compost site at 370 Winter Street. Residential permit required. Call DPW@ 781.762.1413. Norwood strives to be in compliance with DEP's Anti-Idling clean air regulations requiring car engines to not idle for more than 5 minutes. Please shut your car engine off, if you will be longer than 5 minutes. Your compliance is appreciated.
3. **CURBSIDE PICK UP**—place yard debris (including potted plants) in **ONLY** tall brown leaf bags available at grocery stores and Home Depot. Place leaf bags (not to exceed 50 lbs.) curbside on your regular trash/recycle pick up date. Leaf bags are picked up weekly, April through November.

Recycle carts are for **ONLY** clean papers, clean cardboard, empty milk cartons, juice bxs, and clean containers such as glass, tin and plastics. Please go to Recycle Often. Recycle Right @ [recycleoftenrecycleright.com](http://recycleoftenrecycleright.com)
