




Q2 Please indicate your level of agreement or disagreement with the following statement: "Hudson should strive to expand Conservation areas and increase open space."









Q5 Please indicate your level of agreement or disagreement with the following statement: "Hudson should strive to preserve the community character and integrity of existing neighborhoods."








