## SOUHEGAN RIVER TRAIL

The Souhegan River Trail project connects the newly-created Watson Park close to the mouth of the Souhegan River to the state-recognized scenic waterfall and the 80-acre Wildcat Falls Park. Planned improvements include:

1. Modifications to allow passage through the sluiceway in the Chamberlain Bridge
2. Installation of a small pedestrian bridge over the bog near the fire station
3. Construction of approximately 2500' of non-motorized multi-use paths
