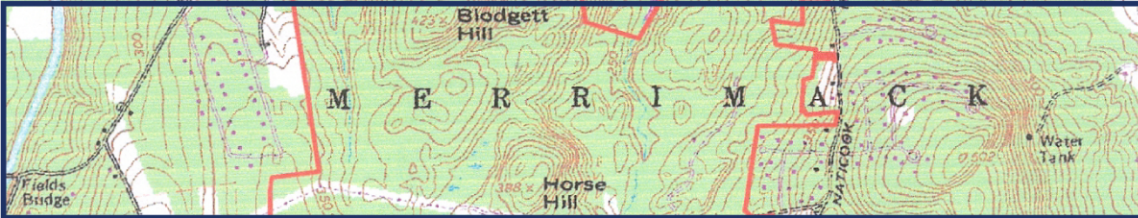

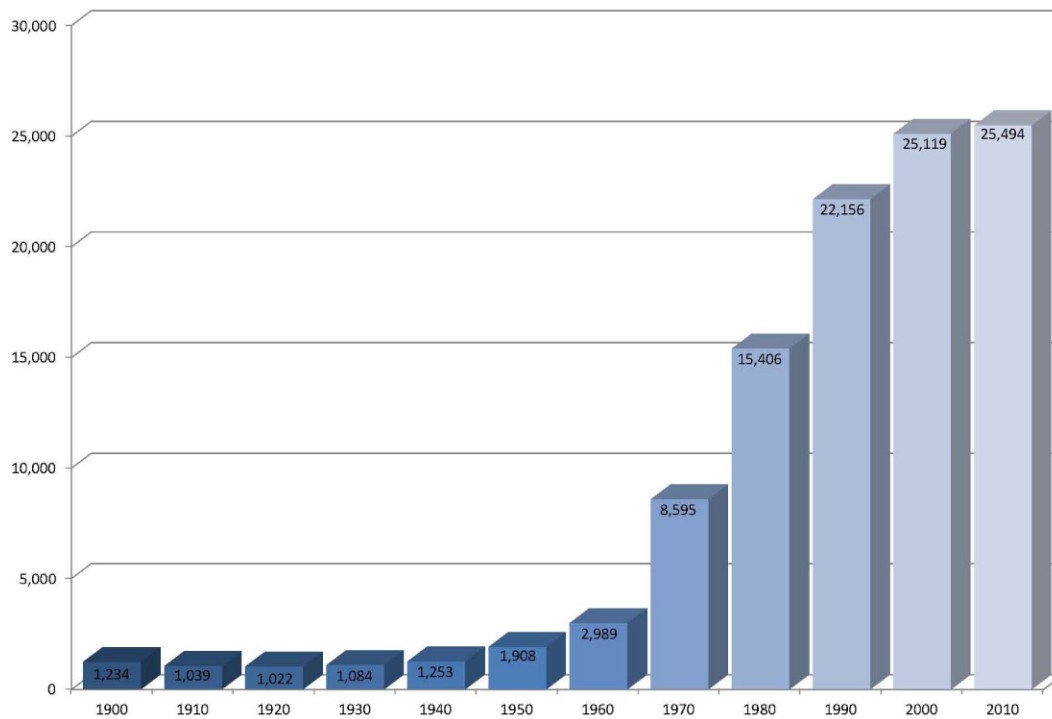

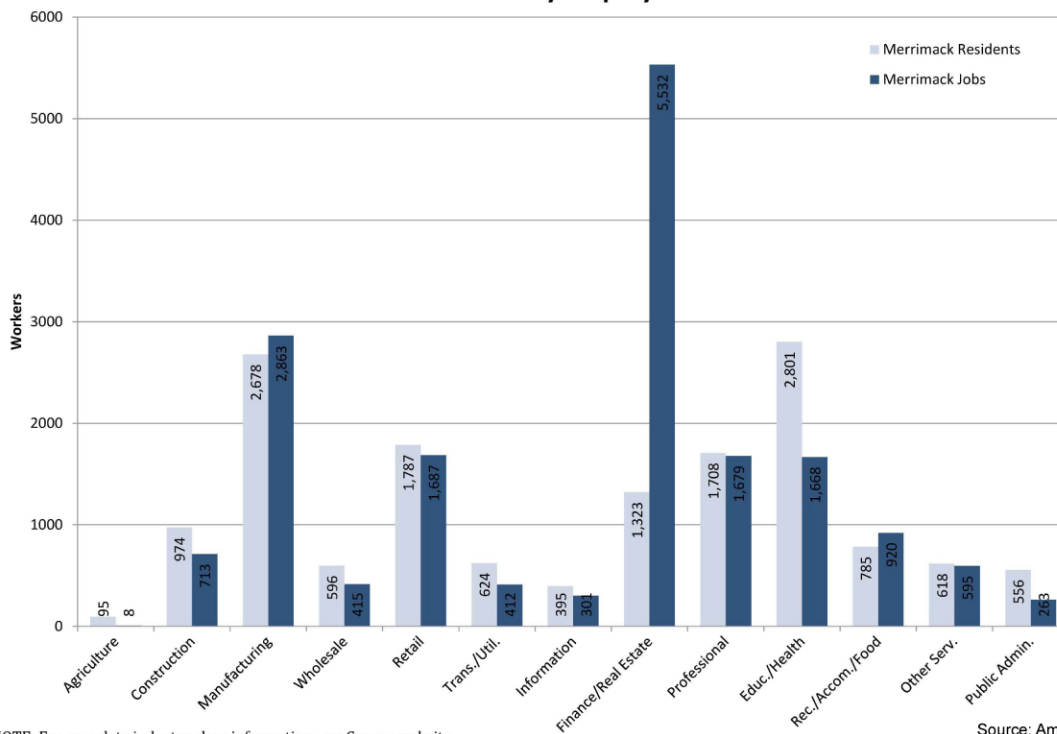


Merrimack Population (1900-2010)
