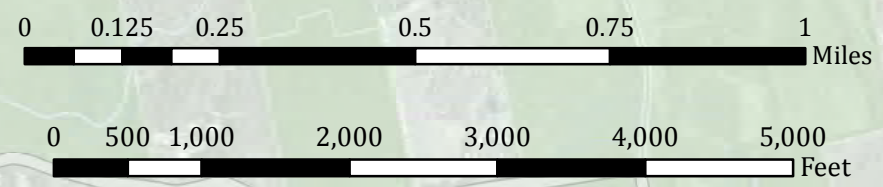

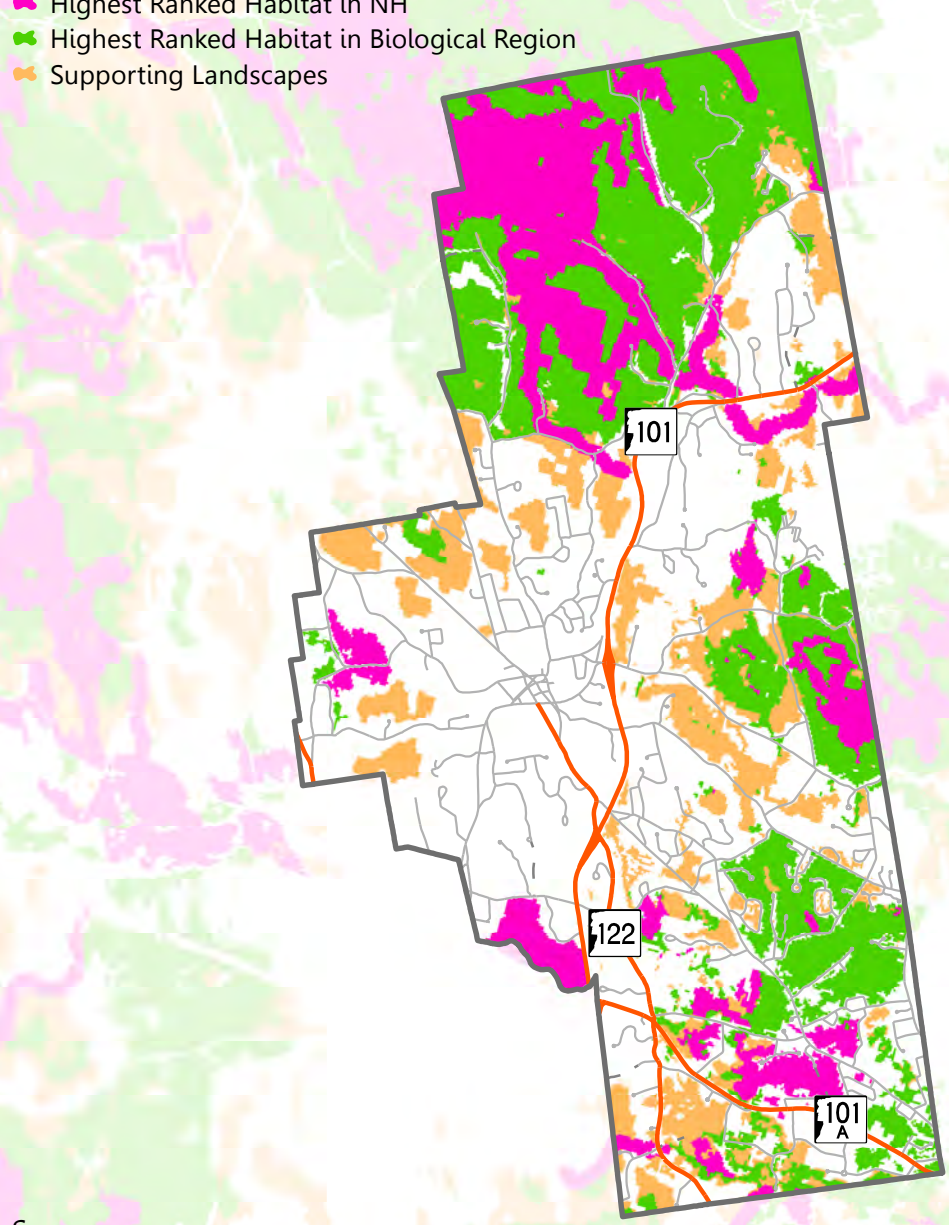

IMPORTANT HABITATS



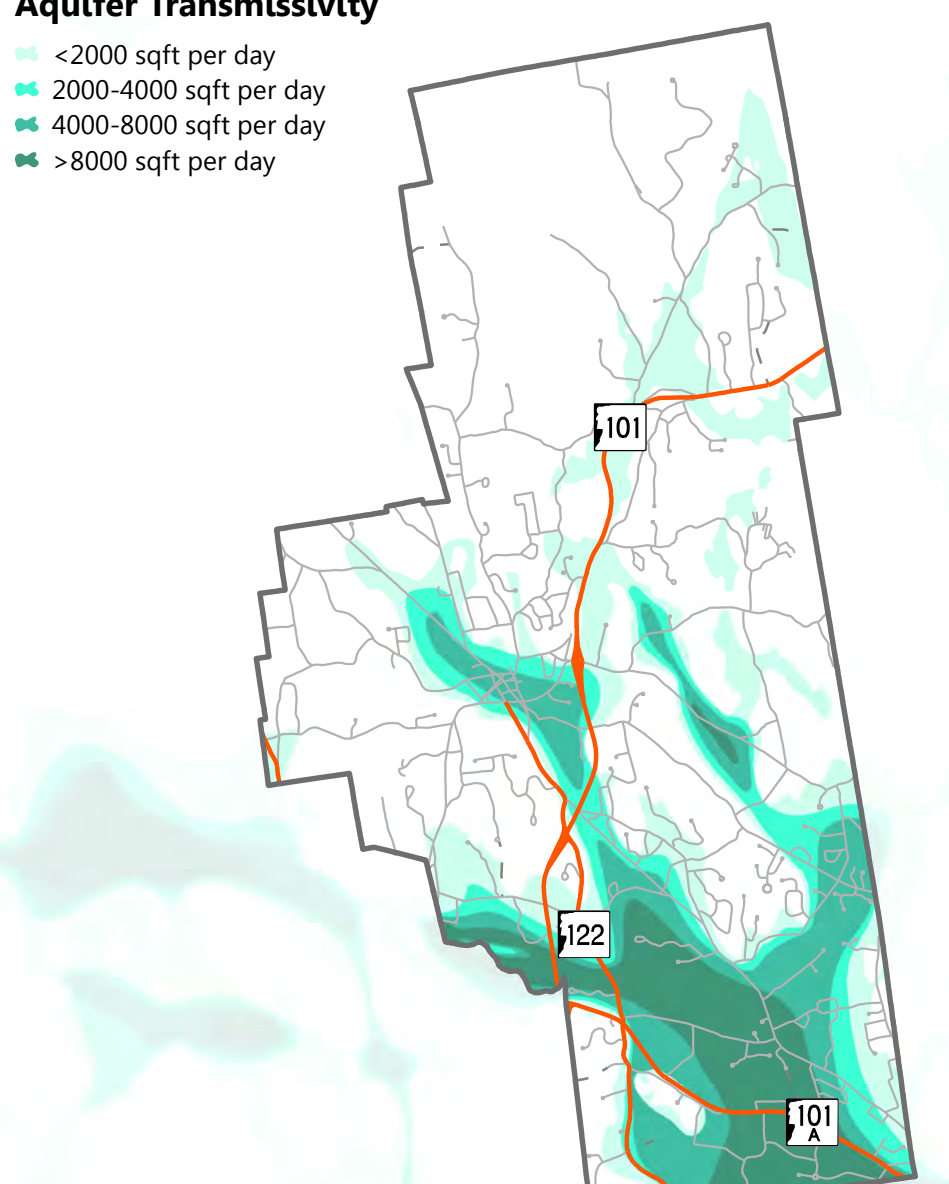

IMPORTANT SOILS



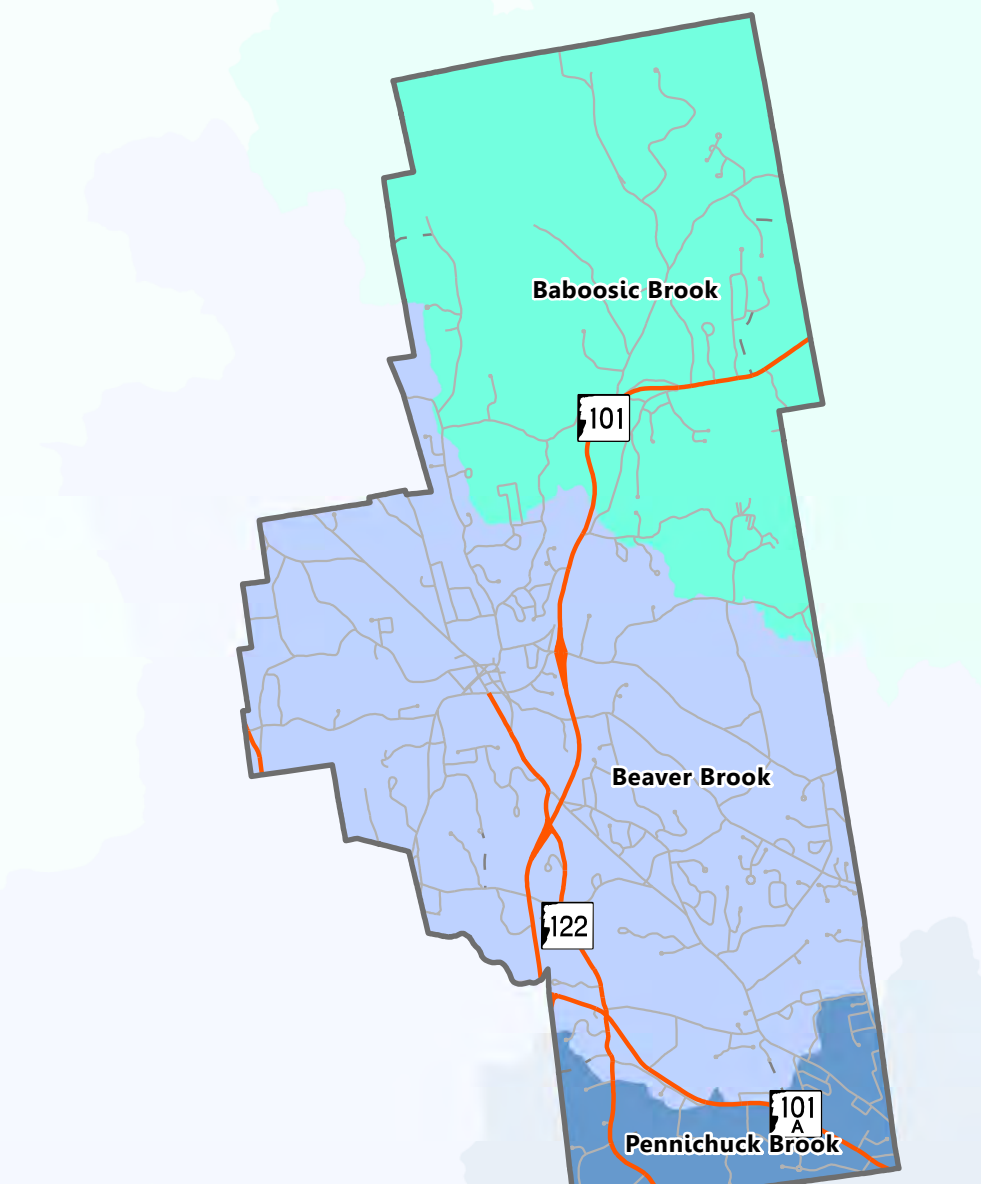
