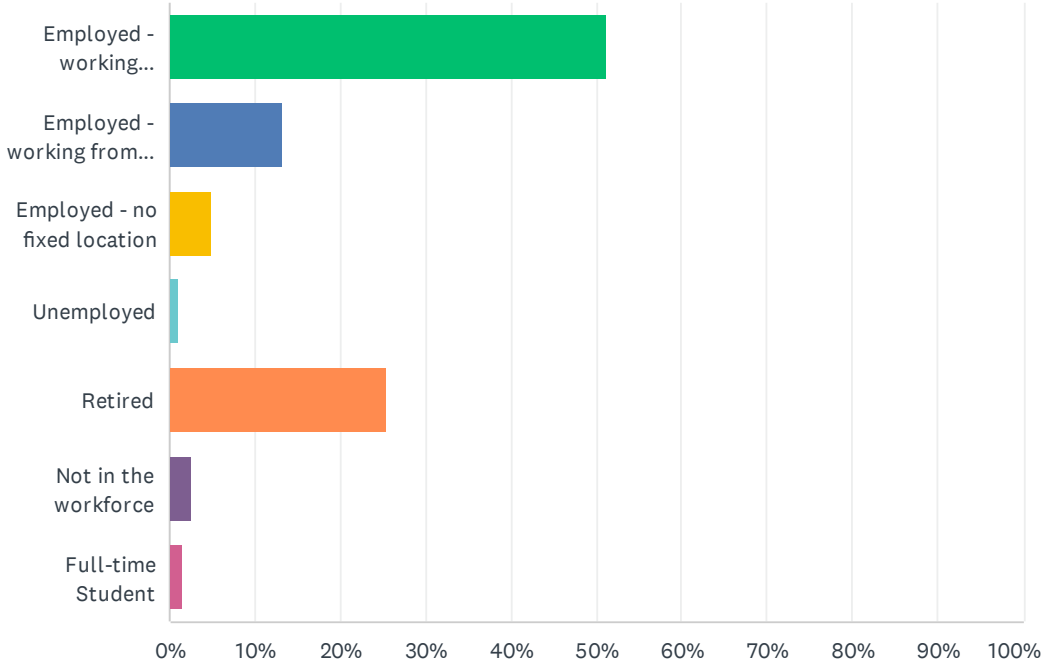


Q1 What is your current employment status? Please check the answer that best applies to you.

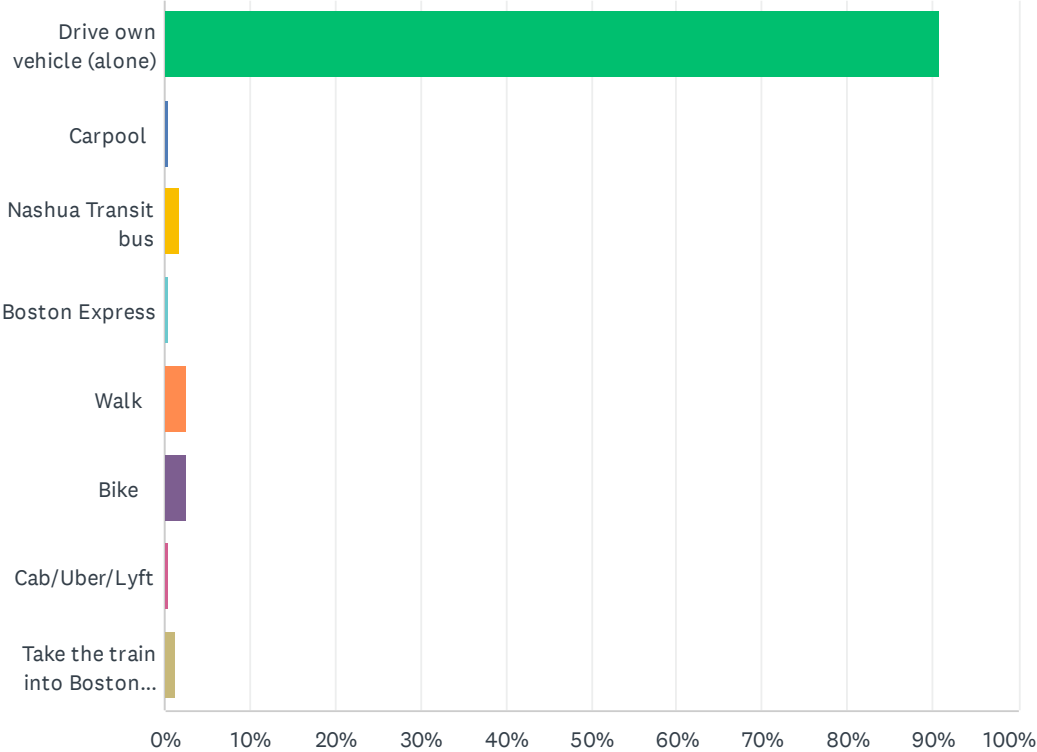

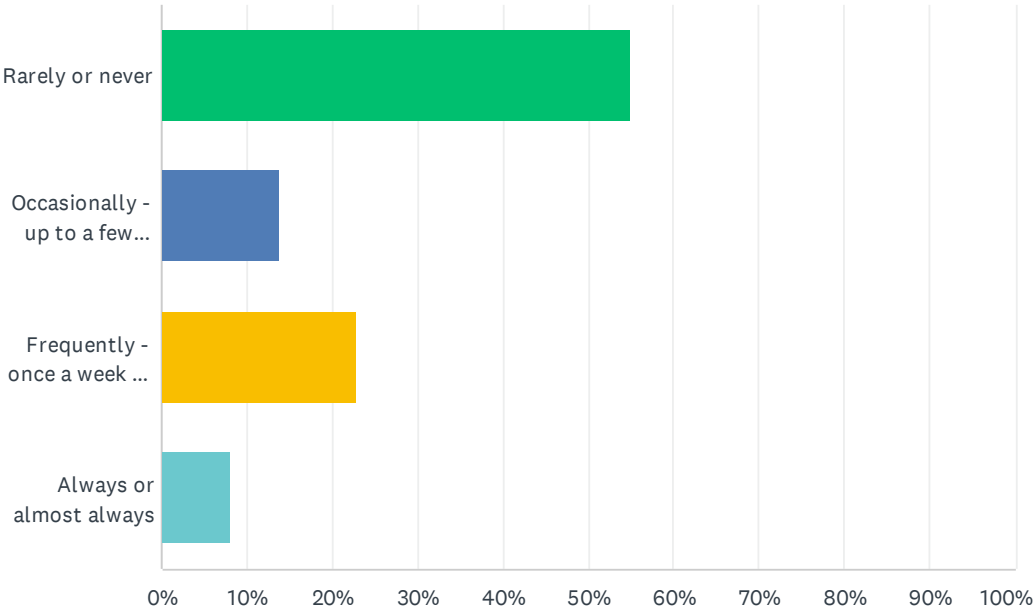

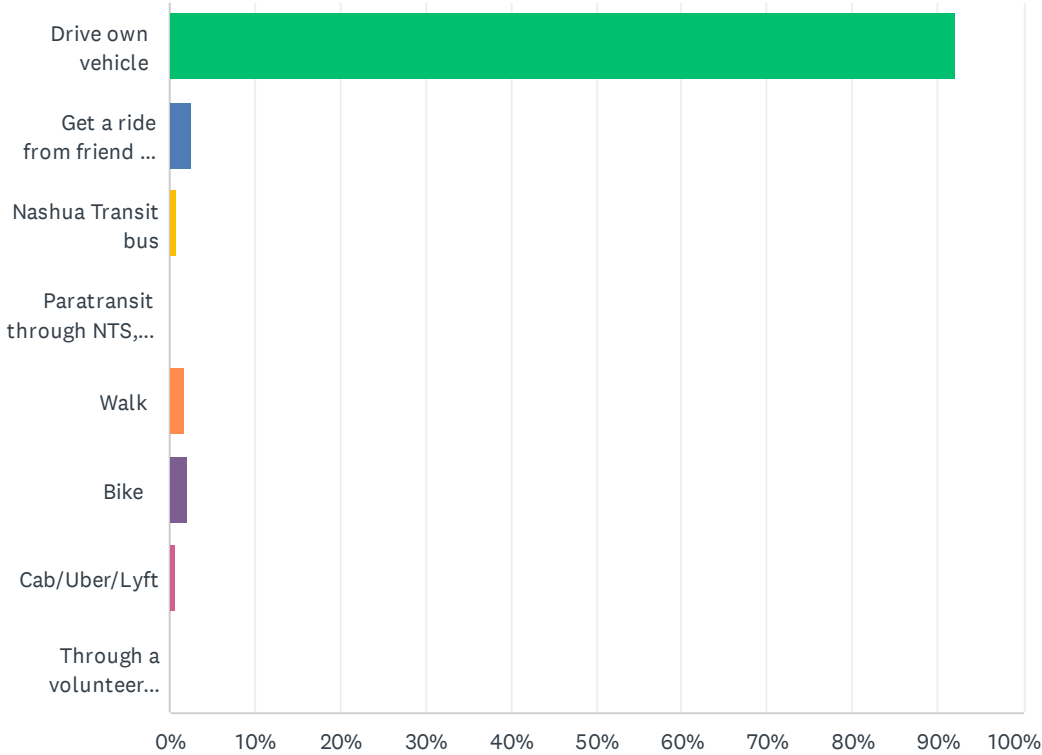

Q4 What is the primary way you typically travel for non-work related purposes such as shopping, medical appointments, or socializing?

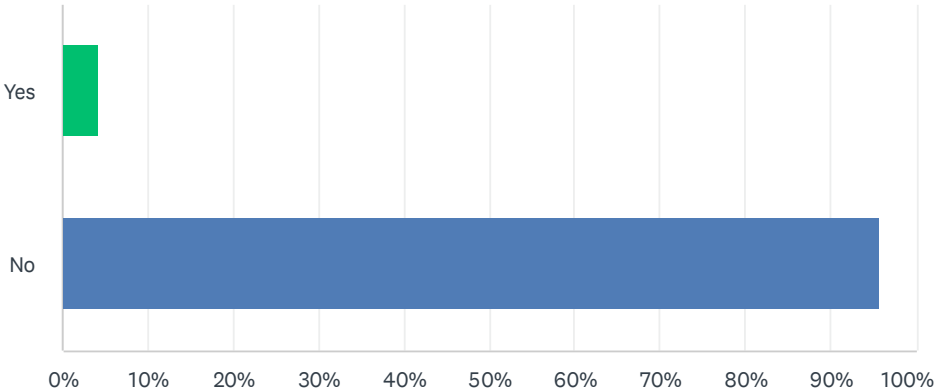

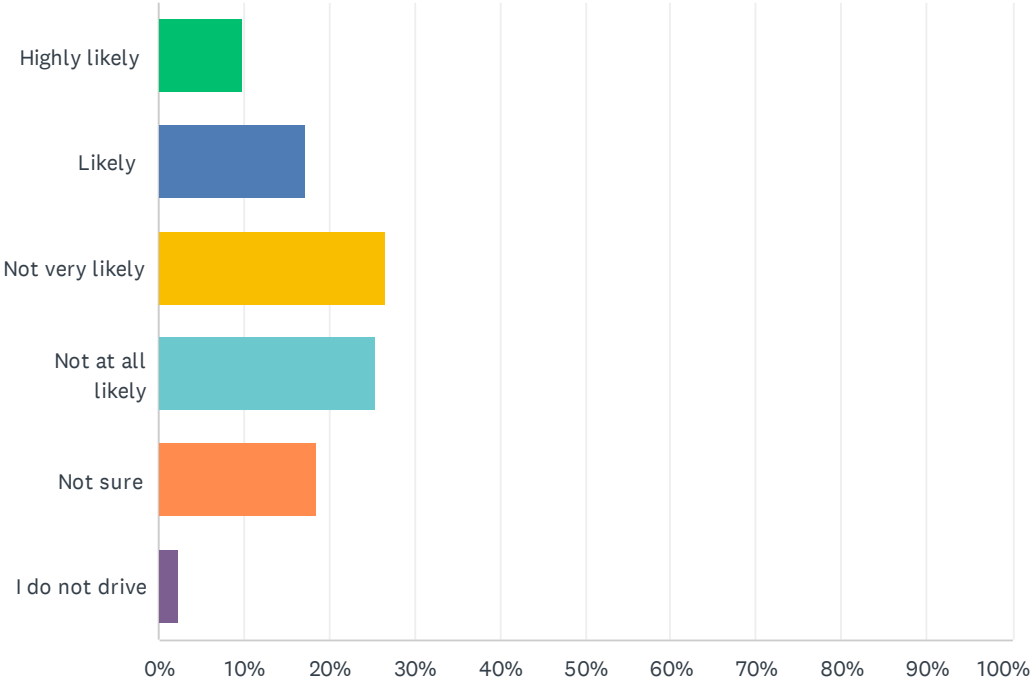

Q6 How likely would you be to make your next car purchase an electric vehicle?

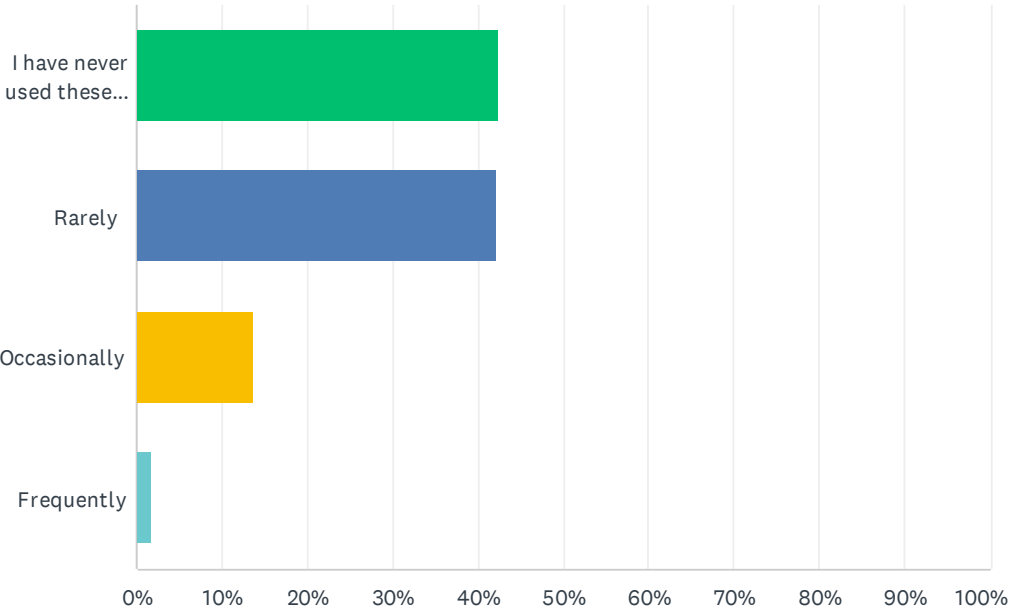

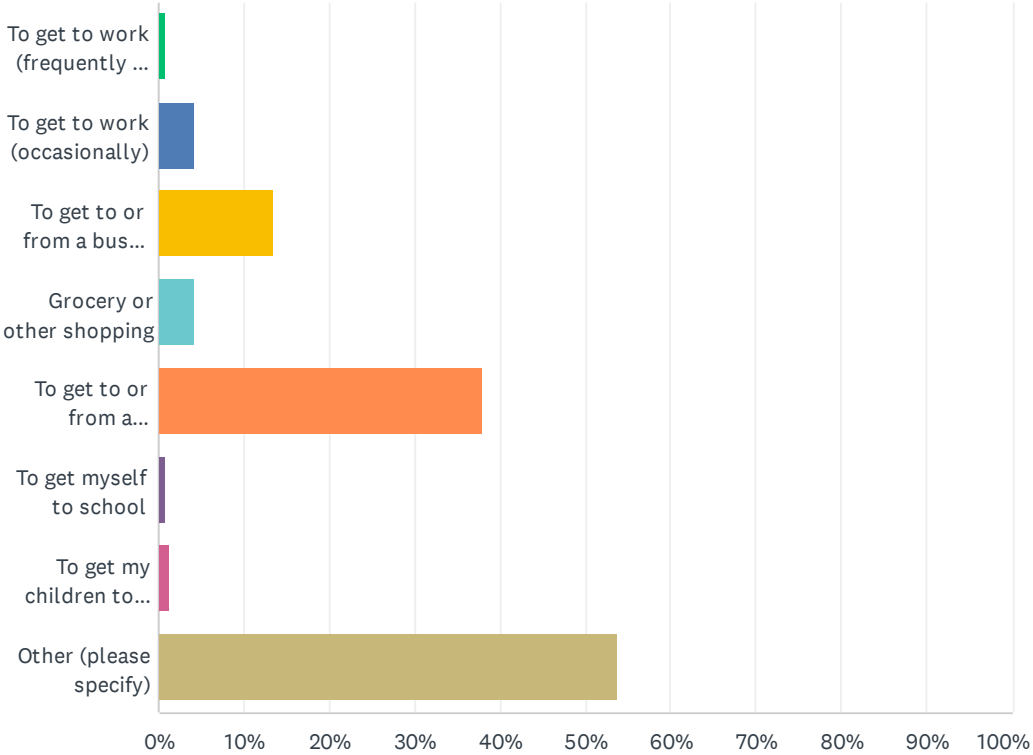

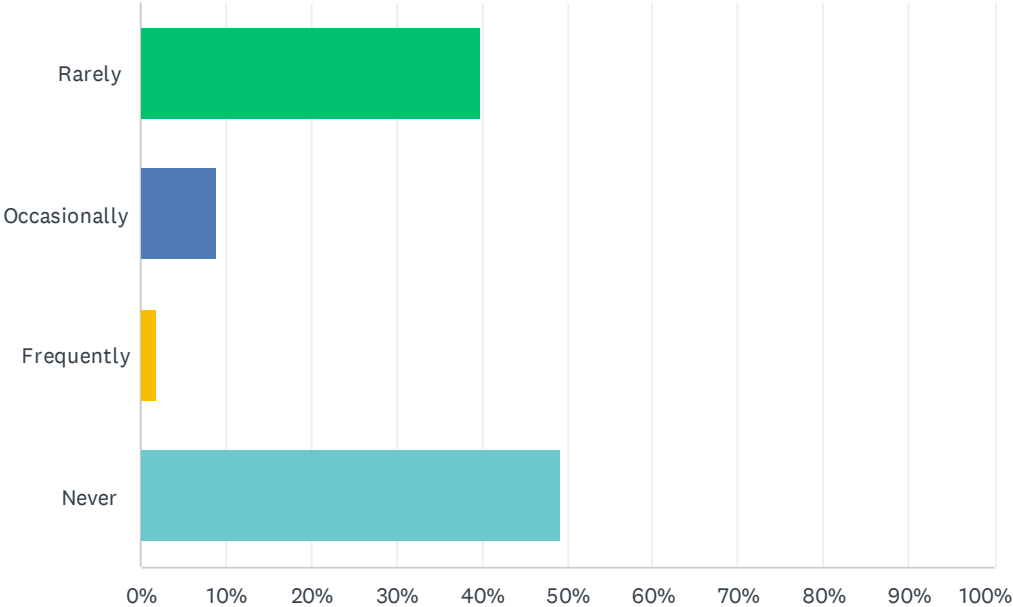

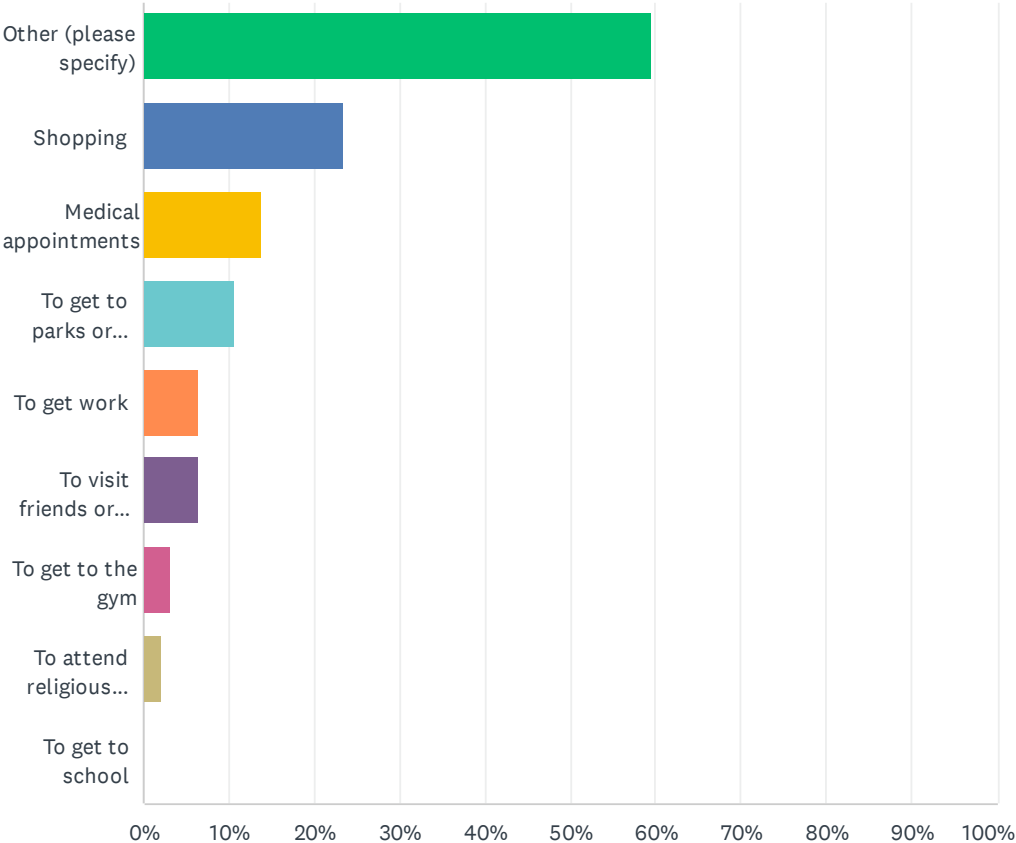

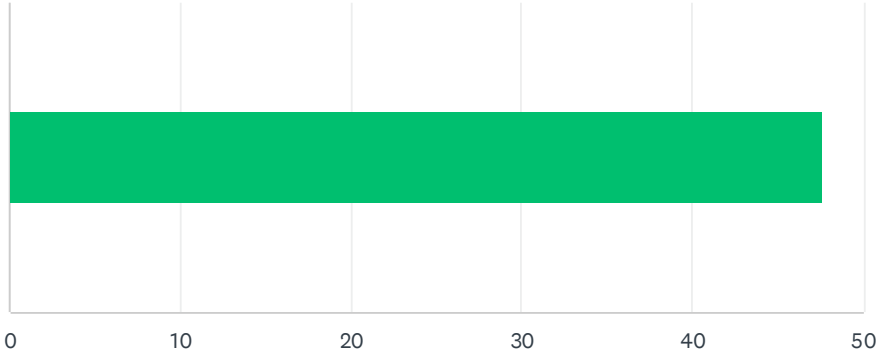

Q11 How would you rate NTS fixed-route bus service? Use the sliding scale below to rate NTS service with 0 being the lowest rating and 10 the highest.

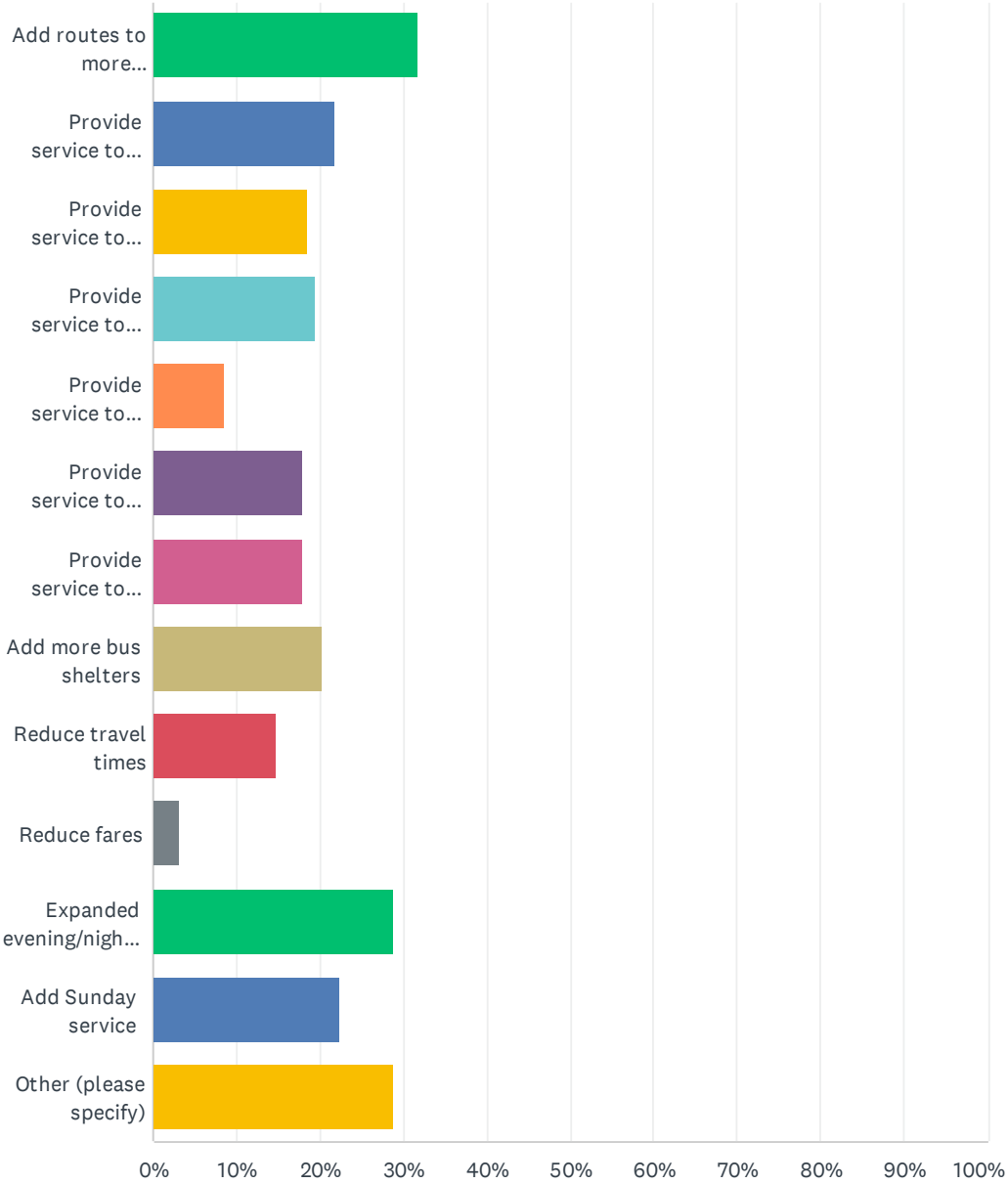

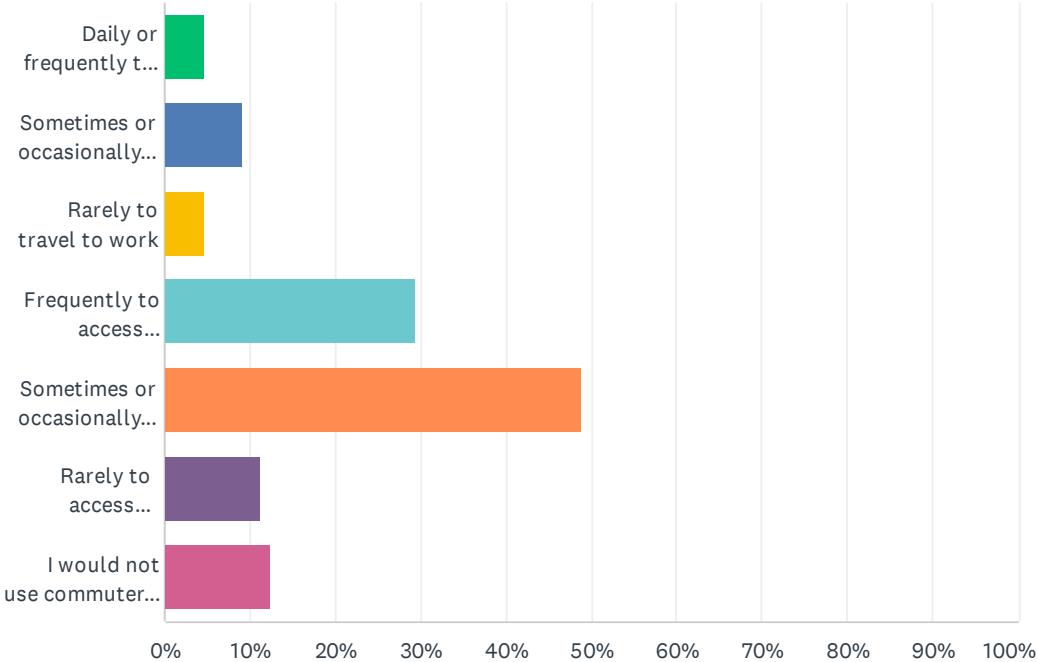

Q17 If commuter rail service were provided between North Station in Boston and Nashua, how likely would you be to use the service for any of the purposes indicated below? Select no more than two.

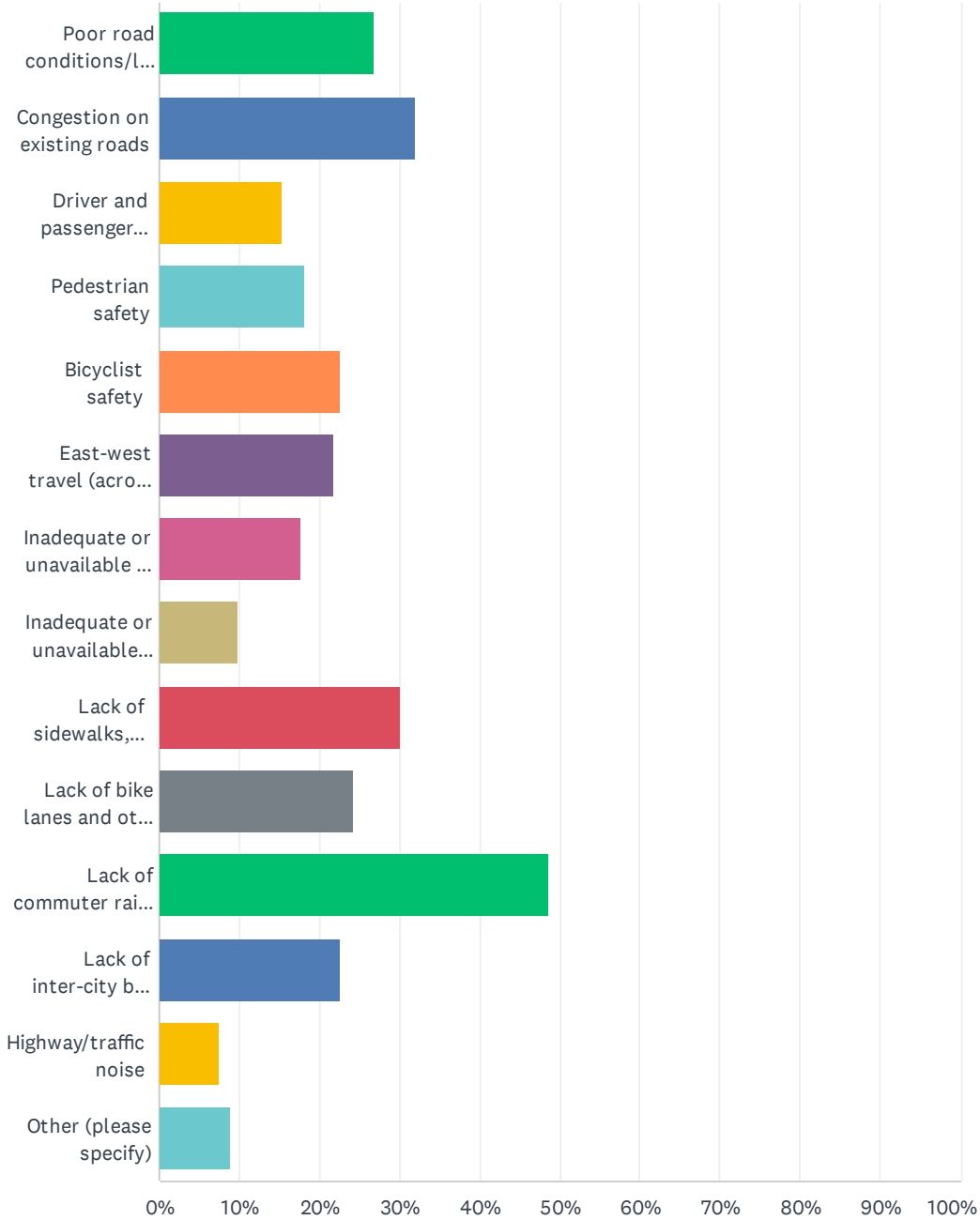

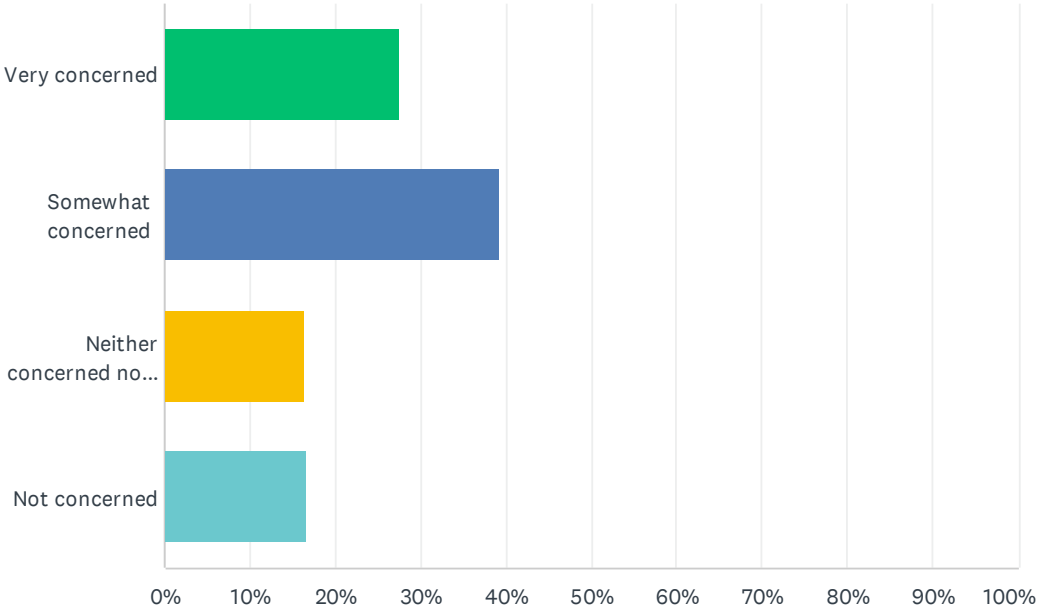
