

City of Oak Park - Primary and Secondary Route Map

DID YOU KNOW?

During snow events, the Department of Public Works (DPW) prioritizes the roadways in which it plows and/or salts. In general, the City crews treat and plow roadways in the following order:

Primary Roadways - Primary roads are the first priority for plowing and de-icing. Primary routes include major streets such as the I-696 service drives, Greenfield Road, Coolidge Hwy., 11 Mile Road, and Nine Mile Road.

Secondary Roadways - Secondary roads are main and heavily traveled snow emergency routes around schools and medical facilities. These include streets like Oak Park Boulevard, Scotia, Rosewood, Capital, Lincoln, and Northfield Blvd.

Residential Intersections - Tertiary priority is made to residential intersections so that vehicles can properly stop and proceed safely at intersection roadways. Residential roadways are plowed when appropriate, typically when four or more inches of snow is present or other circumstances necessitate.
