Oak Park & Bark Dog Park is located at 21950 Scotia Rd. **The park is open daily, year-round from 7 am to 9 pm and it closes from 8 to 11 am on Mondays for maintenance.** The park has drinking water for dogs and humans, a paw wash station, seasonally, and bags for waste disposal. Entrance into the dog park is controlled by a keyless electronic system.

Oak Park & Bark is 1.64 acres and is divided into three sections – 1.3 acres dedicated for large dogs over 25 lbs., 0.18 acres for small dogs under 25 lbs., and .16 acres for yellow ribbon dogs with special needs (those with physical or emotional challenges).

How to Apply for a Membership

The annual fee is \$40 for residents. We currently are not accepting applications from non-residents.

You are registering as the owner of your pet, for the dog park. Any other person who may take your dog(s) to the park without you, must also register. This means watching the required online video, completing the quiz, and submitting a photocopy of your driver's license along with all required paperwork.

Additionally, a replacement fob is \$20, and a replacement tag is \$10.

If you would like to register more than one dog (up to three dogs), each dog is \$10.

STEP ONE: Prepare the paperwork to be submitted.

Paperwork needed:

1. Proof of up-to-date City of Oak Park Dog License (Purchase this with the City of Oak Park's Public Safety Department)

2. Current vaccinations – MUST include Rabies, DHLPP, and Bordetella with their expiration dates.
3. Proof of spay/neuter.

Complete and submit application, including the compliance video and quiz. You must score a 70/100 on this quiz to continue with the membership process.

STEP TWO: Submit application.

STEP THREE: Payment & Pickup

Once all paperwork has been approved, you will make payment in the Recreation Office, or online.

We will take applications/payments on a first-come, first-serve basis until we are at capacity.

If applying remotely, once payment is confirmed, your tag & fob will be available for pick up in the City of Oak Park's Recreation Office (14300 Oak Park Blvd) if not applying in person.
