

### Oak Park Rules and Regulations

1. \_\_\_ Permit holders are responsible for compliance with the City of Oak Park Dog Park rules and regulations listed in this agreement at all times.
2. \_\_\_ The City of Oak Park is **NOT** responsible for permit holder's dogs, or any injuries caused by their dogs.
3. \_\_\_ Use of the City of Oak Park Dog Park is at the permit holders' own risk.
4. \_\_\_ Permit holders and their approved dogs are the only ones allowed to use the City of Oak Park Dog Park. Your permit can be revoked if you allow a non-permit holder or unregistered dog into the park.
5. \_\_\_ The following **are not permitted** in the City of Oak Park Dog Park: dog toys or balls, dogs in heat; dogs under the age of four months; dogs with contagious diseases or parasites; pinch, prong or shock collars; aggressive dogs; dogs that have been identified as dangerous by the City of Oak Park or court of law; people food or dog food (including treats); alcoholic beverages; glass containers; cigarettes, cigars, vaping, marijuana or drugs.
6. \_\_\_ Dogs must be on a six-foot leash until inside enclosure.
7. \_\_\_ Up to 3 dogs per household may be registered. Two dogs per owner/handler are allowed at one time in the park.
8. \_\_\_ Dogs must be actively always supervised and be under voice control of their owner(s).
9. \_\_\_ Permit holders must always remain with their dog inside the City of Oak Park Dog Park.
10. \_\_\_ Owners must clean up their dog(s)' waste and deposit it in the receptacles provided.
11. \_\_\_ Digging is not allowed in the Oak Park Dog Park. Owners are responsible for filling in any holes dug by their dog(s) by using the dirt provided in the designated bin.
12. \_\_\_ Laptop/tablet use is not allowed in the park. Limit any phone conversations to under 2 minutes to ensure your dog is properly supervised.
13. \_\_\_ Dogs barking excessively or exhibiting aggressive behavior must be removed from the Dog Park at the first sign of this behavior. Any dog that bites another dog or human will no longer be allowed in the park and will be immediately removed from the owner's permit.
14. \_\_\_ Dogs must wear their City of Oak Park license tag, as well as the annual Oak Park Dog Park tag (received upon permit purchase) at all times.
15. \_\_\_ No acts of aggression will be tolerated; either verbal or physical, by a permit holder towards another permit holder or another permit holder's dog.
16. \_\_\_ Adults (18 years and over) may apply for a permit. Children ages 13-17 are permitted at the Oak Park Dog Park if they are under the adult supervision of a permit holder. Children under 12 are not allowed in the Oak Park Dog Park.
17. \_\_\_ The Park is split into three sections: One section for large dogs over 25lbs, one section for small dogs under 25lbs, and one section for yellow ribbon dogs with special needs.

18. \_\_\_\_ In the event that any of the above rules are violated by a permit holder or a complaint is made by another permit holder, The City of Oak Park reserves the right to immediately suspend, or revoke permits of all parties involved. Disciplinary actions do not take place without an investigation by a Parks and Recreation representative. Complaints can be submitted in writing by visiting our website @\_\_\_\_\_. Complaints must be received within one week of the incident.
