Dear Oak Park Neighbors:

Oak Park is on the move again! Through both, new and renewed partnerships, our great City is once again building momentum toward becoming one of the best places to live and work in the region.

*Business Strategies*

The best news is that the City of Oak Park qualifies for support from the Oakland County Main Street Program relative to the economic development of our "midtown" area at 9 Mile and Coolidge. In preparation, I recently reached out to hundreds of Oak Park businesses with the goal of promoting growth and increasing vitality. I met with major stakeholders in the city to discuss ways to attract businesses and shoppers to Oak Park. Special thanks to Huntington Bank and Mr. Jonna for sponsoring a breakfast for more than one hundred business owners eager to work together to bring energy to the city.

The City of Oak Park recently joined forces with the Ferndale Area Chamber of Commerce to host a campaign to display available commercial properties and attract new investment. Residents, business owners, elected officials, the faith community, and non-profit organizations are coming together to develop and implement an action plan to draw new families and businesses to our community.

*Strong Partnerships*

Religious leaders of our community were invited to attend an Oak Park Area Interfaith Forum to discuss strengths we can build on and issues we can work on together. Meetings have been well attended by pastors, rabbis, and our priests, who met to share their visions for the city's future.

My administration actively participates in cooperative regional organizations – which have recently included meetings of the Eight Mile Boulevard Association, the Southeast Oakland County Mayor's Association, SEMCOG, and the Michigan Municipal League. The networking and alliances that result from this outreach will accrue to benefit our city for years to come.

*Community News*

Special thanks to our neighborhood business partner, PNC Bank, for providing financial assistance that helped to save both, the popular Spooktacular Halloween event and the Winterfest. Although these two events were not budgeted, they were made possible by public/private partnerships. The Oak Park High School Football Team turned the corner winning the league championships; and the Marching Band took top honors in state competitions. More important, student educational performance is improving and city-school cooperation is at an all-time high. In addition to being a great benefit to our students, this level of cooperation bodes well for our real estate market.

*Administration Headlines*

I am pleased to announce that renovations to the Oak Park Library and Community Center are nearing completion; and construction of the new Municipal Building is finally underway. We also have a new City Manager, Erik Tungate, who brings a strong background in business development, and fresh, new ideas to our city. Also of note, Oak Park has been praised by recognized pest control experts for our aggressive and highly effective rodent control program, which is spearheaded by our Code Enforcement Division.

*Looking Ahead*

Despite all that has been done, the task of recovering from economic stress has only just begun. Together we will find ways to do more with less and maintain the quality of life we treasure in Oak Park. There are no easy answers; but together we can find solutions we can live with. 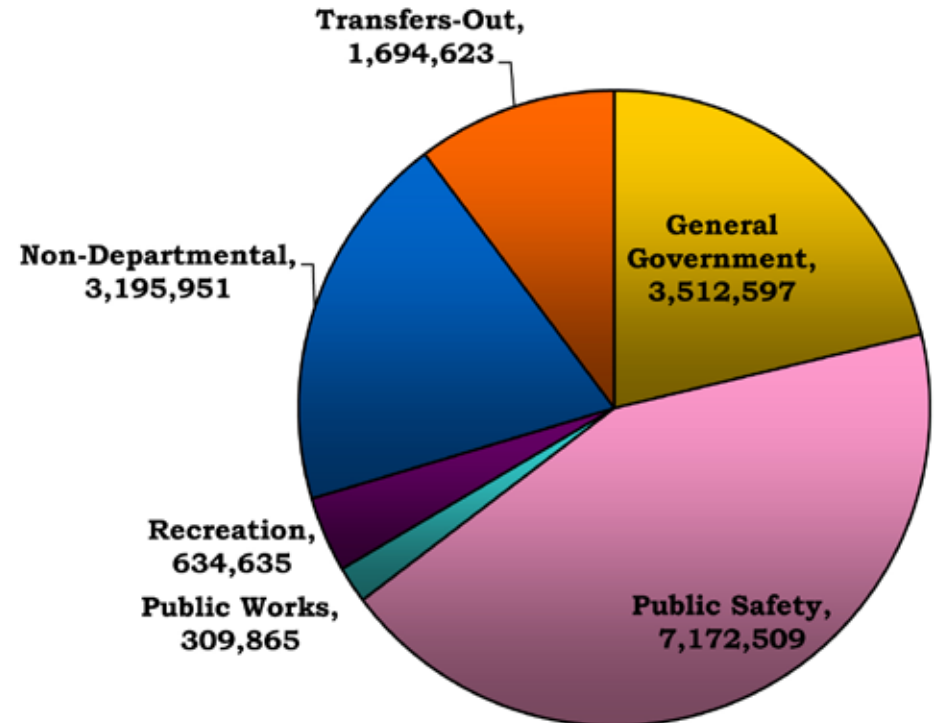
