Our Mission: In the City of Oak Park, we strive to provide the highest quality of life for our residents in everything we do. We pride ourselves on the richness of our cultural diversity and our safe and secure neighborhoods. We actively encourage residential and business growth. We are business-minded and family-centered.

Dear Neighbors:

As we usher in a new year, we celebrate the accomplishments of our past, which make us stronger and even more determined to fulfill the City of Oak Park's vision as the region's premier destination for vibrant, cutting edge community life.

When I assumed office in 2011, I inherited the worst financial crisis in our city's history. A \$2 million pending budget shortfall forced the city to make difficult personnel cuts. However, through the guidance of our City Manager, Erik Tungate, we were able to eliminate the shortfall in a budget of \$17.4 million and turn it into an unprecedented 12% general fund balance in 2014.

Today, your city government is leaner and more effective than ever. We continue to find ways to save money and spend wisely. We saved millions of dollars, for example, on health care costs alone and hired one of the top firms in the country to manage our pension funds at a savings to the city.

Public Safety remains our top priority. Neighboring communities envy our Public Safety Department because of the quality of our highly-trained officers and our excellent response times. I was delighted to swear in eight, new Public Safety Officers last year and to welcome additional Code Enforcement Officers charged with fighting blight and keeping our city sharp.

Going forward, I'm eager to continue increasing the vibrancy of our beloved city. We made history last year with the issuance of the city's first Tavern Licenses to restaurants that can now offer beer and wine to diners. This represents just one of the strategies in the comprehensive economic development plan that residents helped us design. Other tools include: outdoor dining permits, our façade improvement program for local businesses and attractive city welcome signs.

While there are still obstacles to overcome as in any community, our city stands in a different place now thanks to the efforts of our excellent City Manager and his staff. Our biggest challenge last year centered on the environmental crisis caused by the most catastrophic rainfall and subsequent flood in the city's history. I have always been proud of the City of Oak Park; however, the way our community pulled together – neighbors helping neighbors and city workers pulling out all stops to restore our beautiful city in short order – gave me an even deeper sense of pride.

This is an exciting time to be living in our great city. We can all look forward to continuing the positive trends in the coming year.
