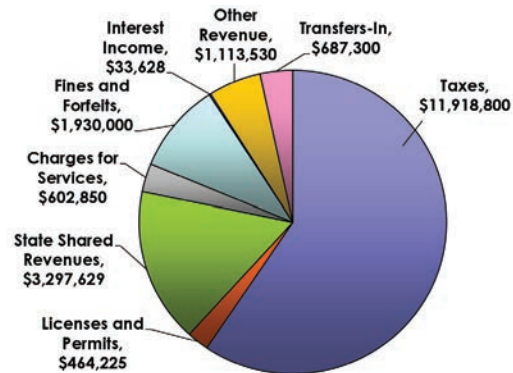

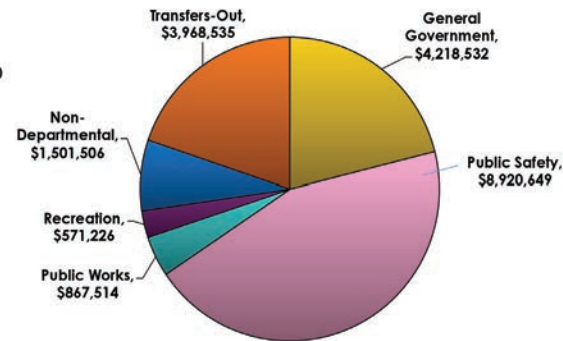


2016-2017 General Fund Budget
