

What kinds of activities should you report?

- Contamination to lakes, rivers and streams
- Pollution entering a storm drain or surface water
- Suspicious dumping to drains and/or surface waters
- Suspicious discharges from pipes
- Sewage discharges on the ground or into surface water
- Large numbers of dead fish
- Failing septic systems
- Construction site soil erosion entering surface waters
- Polluted stormwater runoff from storage piles and dumpsters
- Illegal connections of sanitary sewers to storm drains or surface waters

Please provide the following information when you call:

- Your name and phone number (you can remain anonymous if you choose)
- The source of pollution and what was spilled
- Quantity of spill
- Body of water impacted
- When spill occurred
- Major cross roads of spill or known address
