## **TOWN OF OGDEN BRUSH, STUMP & BAGGED OR RAKED LEAF PICK-UP RULES**

Please remember the following when placing brush, stumps, and bagged or raked leaves by the roadside for pickup:

- ✓ Have all brush, stumps and raked or bagged leaves out to the curb by 7:00am Monday of the week of your quadrant pick up. Brush, stumps, and raked or bagged leaves will be picked up using the quadrant system only. (Quadrant listing available on the web @ [www.Ogdenny.com](http://www.Ogdenny.com) under the highway page.) Leaves that are raked to your property's edge will be picked up separately with our vacuum trucks.
- ✓ All leaves must be raked to the edge of your property but not in the roadway. Leaves in bags can be set in the same area. Only biodegradable bags are acceptable. Leaves in plastic bags will not be picked up as they clog the leaf grinder.
- ✓ DO NOT place brush, stumps, or bagged or raked leaves on anyone's property except for your own.
- ✓ DO NOT place brush pile, stumps, or bagged or raked leaves where they will be a sight distance problem for you, your neighbors, or other traffic.
- ✓ Stack brush parallel with the road.
- ✓ DO NOT place brush, stumps, or bagged or raked leaves under utility wires where our grapple or vacuum truck cannot reach, if possible.
- ✓ Brush and leaves will NOT be picked up if they are in barrels, trash cans or containers.
- ✓ DO NOT place brush piles, stumps, or bagged or raked leaves in the roadway or on the road shoulder.
- ✓ Place stumps separate from brush and leaf piles. They will be picked up separately.
- ✓ All stumps must be 90% free of all dirt and stones and no more than 6" in diameter.
- ✓ Contractors are not permitted to bring in any stumps from another location. They will NOT be picked up.
- ✓ DO NOT include brush, stumps, or bagged or raked leaves from "lot clearing" for any construction activity. They will NOT be picked up.
- ✓ DO NOT place ANY other debris with your brush, stumps or in your leaf piles. (Examples: metal, concrete, construction materials, wood with nails, junk, "Spring cleanup items" etc.) You must contact your personal waste hauler for all items except concrete. Contact our office for concrete removal.
- ✓ The Town does not pick up grass clippings.
