Susan Howard is a long-time resident of New Hampshire, having moved here from Long Island, NY, in 1989. She currently calls Peterborough home after renting in the Antrim/Bennington area for many years.

Susan's personal, volunteer, and work experiences have made her keenly aware of the social welfare issues affecting the Monadnock Region.

In 2009, Susan was hired as a part-time Program Manager at Monadnock Area Transitional Shelter (MATS), which quickly transitioned to a full-time position. Working with MATS, Susan sees first-hand the challenges the housing crisis in NH has on families and communities, especially in the Monadnock Region.

Watching families move from this area or experience homelessness due to the inability to find affordable rental housing influenced Susan's decision to join the Affordable Housing Committee and work towards finding solutions to this issue.
